

CELEBRATING INTERNATIONAL INFECTION PREVENTION WEEK

ICNs Shine at our webinar series.

In October, in recognition of International Infection Prevention Week, NurseIndia partnered with Cygnia Healthcare to bring a series of informative webinars hosted by Master Trainer Thankam Gomez. Each session has been a valuable learning opportunity for healthcare professionals, focusing on critical strategies for infection control and patient safety.

All the webinars are available on Cygnia Healthcare's YouTube channel. Each has been expertly led by Infection Control Nurses (ICNs) from prestigious hospitals across India and abroad. Here's a quick recap:

1. Non-Ventilator Acquired Pneumonia (NV-HAP)

Hosted by Halle Tlangete, ICN from Max Hospital, Gurgaon, this session on 11th October focused on understanding and preventing NV-HAP, a common yet preventable hospital-acquired infection.





2. All About Extravasation

On 14th October, Rakshita D, ICN at Manipal Hospital, Bangalore, delved into the complexities of extravasation and the best practices for preventing this adverse event during patient care.

3. Strategies to Prevent Infections in Acute Care Settings

Rajeswari R, Infection Nursing Officer from Apollo Proton Cancer Centre, Chennai, shared practical strategies to minimize infections in acute care environments on **17th October.**









4. Strategies to Prevent Surgical Site Infections (SSI)

Aswathy G, Infection Control Nurse Manager at Gleneagles HealthCity, Chennai, took the lead on **21st October** to discuss SSI prevention measures that can significantly reduce post-operative complications.

5. Cleaning, Disinfection, and Environmental Hygiene

With an international perspective, **Amandeep Kaur** from Canada highlighted the role of rigorous cleaning and disinfection in infection prevention on **25th October.**





6. Strategies to Prevent Central Line-Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSI)

On **28th October**, **Blessy Angel Younus** from Bombay Hospital, Indore, provided evidence-based insights into reducing the risk of CLABSI, one of the most critical areas in infection control.

7. Prevention of Ventilator Associated Pneumonia

On **4th of November, Feba Siby** - Infection Control Nurse at Manipal Hospital, Pune provided evidencebased insights into reducing the Ventilator Associated Pneumonia (VAP) cases in critical care settings.

Conferences That Shaped Conversations





All that made news in the world of Nursing

1. Japanese healthcare major Wafukai has reached out to CM Bhajan Lal Sharma of Rajasthan for assistance in recruiting suitable nurses. Sharma has directed Rajasthan Nursing Council (RNC) to compile a list of those interested. RNC is collaborating with nursing colleges to identify qualified applicants, who will be offered five-year contracts.

2. The Indian Nursing Council in collaboration with University of Houston, introduces DNP courses to India.

3. Indian nursing council also introduced specialized geriatric nurse practitioner course.

4. The International Council of Nurses Board of Directors has approved the formation of an innovative new ICN body representing student and early career nurses.

5. Nurse Maria Victoria Juan from Philippines wins Aster Guardians Global Nursing Award 2024, taking home 250,000 USD prize money in an event held in Bengaluru, India this year.
