As summer comes to an end it's time to look to our yards and get them in order. Many homes are in violation of the HOA rules and we need a course correction. Below is a list of items that we have seen that need to be addressed.

- Remove weeds in flower beds, and inside bushes
- Cut back trees and bushes interfering with travel on sidewalks
- Install working lights in lamp posts
- Remove overgrown plants or weeds around lamp posts and mailboxes
- Clear weeds from City Utility boxes
- Cut down or trim dead trees/partial dead trees
- Ensure improvement projects end quickly
- Tree sprouts
- Take in trash cans
- Store clean trash cans extremely neatly if visible from the street.
- Keep sheds well maintained, clean, painted.

We are asking all residents to take action and avoid violation notices.
