The milking competition is to be held under the rules, regulations and recognition of the British Goat Society. All goats must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and name of the exhibitor, the registered name and number being shown on the entry form, (except Pygmy and Boer goats), plus the kidding date for goats in milk. All goats in milk must have kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to show day.

RULES AND SHOW GUIDANCE

All CAE certificates MUST BE VALID and on approved BGS/Sheep & Goat Health Scheme.

- 1 Exhibitors are requested not to bring to the showground any goat that has ever had a positive reaction to a CAE test.
- 2 Kids entered will be accepted on their dam's C.A.E. status.
- 3 No pregnant goat, or one which has kidded/aborted within the last 30 days may enter the showground.
- 4 Kids must be a minimum or 2 months old by show date. The registration number of any goat initially entered as RAF (Registration Applied For) must be submitted to the Show Secretary before the goat competes.
- No adult goat or goatling will be fed milk or milk substitutes. No goats shall receive stimulants, medicine or drugs without the permission and under the supervision of a Steward or a Veterinary Surgeon.
- 6 Milk produced at the show should not be fed to goats of any age as it appears to have been a factor in the spread of CAE.
- 7 Use of artificial colouring or plugging/sealing of teats will disqualify the animal.
- 8 Only animals whose name and number are in the catalogue may be shown no substitute can be accepted.
- The pail containing the milk of each exhibit should carry a label bearing the name/earmark/show number of the exhibit. This pail must rest level on the ground and be capable of being carried single-handed by a secure handle. The Chief Steward has the right, when checking empty pails prior to commencement of milking, to refuse to allow the use of any container which will not rest level on the ground or is not capable of being carried single-handed by a secure handle.
- No pregnant goat may be admitted to the showground, in event of unforeseen kidding/abortion goats must be immediately isolated from other goats, full details of goat, exhibitor and action taken must be reported in writing by the Chief Steward to BGS Secretary immediately after the show.

No entries will be accepted in the 'B' or 'W' categories relating to Goat Health Scheme forms unless CAE blood test results are on BGS submission forms or Sheep and Goat Health Scheme forms. This is to enable quick and accurate confirmation of the status of the goats attending a show. **GOATS ATTENDING THIS SHOW WILL BE RESTRICTED TO THOSE ELIGIBLE UNDER**CATEGORY 'W' AS DEFINED IN THE BGS GOAT HEALTH CLASSIFICATION. i.e. whole herd negative tested within the 12 months prior to show date, or alternatively current CAE Monitored/Accredited Scheme status.

The use of milking machines is permitted at this show.

All branches to be removed from pens and placed in designated area. Straw and water will be provided.

SHOW TIMETABLE:

<u>Friday evening</u>: All goats in milk must be penned and milked by 6.30 pm for stripping out under supervision. All milking buckets must be handed in to weighing area by 9.00 pm.

<u>Saturday morning</u>: First Inspection of goats in milk at 7.00 am followed by milking. All goats in milk to be stripped out under supervision after morning milking completed, including those only entered for Sunday show. Inspection classes will commence at 10.00 am - young stock, males, Pygmy and Boer goats <u>must be penned by this time.</u>

Saturday afternoon (at conclusion of Saturday show judging) or evening (at time to be notified): Judging of all Sunday show male entries
