

# 11 Salon & Gallery COVID-19 Exposure Control, Mitigation, and Recovery plan

## **PPE Utilization**

All employees and clients are required to wear face coverings at all times in the salon. Masks must be worn correctly, covering both the mouth and nose.

## **Physical Distancing**

The occupancy of the salon will be kept at 50% or lower at all times. Stations and shampoo bowls are set up to be 6 feet apart.

## **Hygiene**

\*Frequent hand washing is required of all employees.

\*Running water and antibacterial soap is provided for all clients and employees.

\*Required hygiene practices are posted in multiple locations.

\*A new cloth cape is used for each client.

## **Sanitation**

\*Common areas are sanitized regularly with EPA approved products. Housekeeping practices are based on the Department of Labor and Industries' and CDC guidelines.

\*Stations and tools are sanitized between each new client.

\*All linens, towels, drapes, smocks, etc., laundered in accordance with WAC 308-20-110

## **Employee Symptom Monitoring**

\*Employees will not arrive to work if they are having any of the following symptoms: fever, chills, cough, fatigue, sore throat, loss of smell or taste,

headaches, muscle or body aches, nausea, vomiting, congestion, runny nose, or shortness of breath.

\*Employees must stay home if they have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. They will then be asked to get a test and quarantine for 14 days after receiving their results if tested positive

\*If an employee has been tested positive, all clients will receive a phone call to inform them they may have been in contact while the employee was tested positive.

### **Client Symptom Monitoring**

\*If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms, please cancel your appointment: fever, chills, cough, fatigue, sore throat, loss of smell or taste, headaches, muscle or body aches, nausea, vomiting, congestion, runny nose, or shortness of breath.

\*Face covering properly worn over the nose and mouth is required in the salon at all times.

\*Please do not bring guests with you to the salon unless you are bringing a child under the age of 16 to their appointment.

\*Call or text the salon or your stylist upon arrival, and wait for instructions to enter


