

The Circle of Fifths

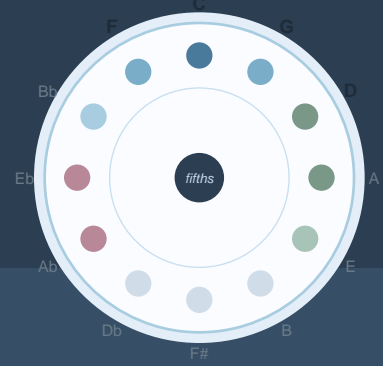

Learn how music actually works, while playing songs you already love.

This is a small-group online program built around the circle of fifths, the map behind how all music is organized. No theory background needed. You just need a piano or keyboard with at least 2 octaves at home (a mini keyboard works perfectly), a stable internet connection, and a love of music.

The 8-Week Journey

One hour per week, online, in a group of 3 to 4 students.

01 First Contact: C Major

Notes, posture, and the C 5-finger position. You will play a real song by the end of this very first session.

Ode to Joy | simple C chord patterns

02 The C Major System

What is a key? Diatonic chords and the I-V-vi-IV progression. Once you see the pattern, you will hear it everywhere.

Let It Be | Stay With Me | Imagine

03 Move Right: G Major

The circle introduced simply. C to G is the same shape with one new note, F sharp. Same songs, new key.

Let Her Go | Lost Boy | Wonderful Tonight

04 Move Left: F Major

C to F: one new note, B flat. Compare all three keys and build your first mini mashup. This is when it clicks.

Sign of the Times | Ophelia | The Scientist

05 Inversions and Flow

Chord inversions in C, G, and F. Smooth transitions between chords and the beginning of song mashups.

Champagne Problems | Somebody That I Used to Know

06 Relative Minors

C to Am, G to Em, F to Dm. The same notes, a completely different emotion. Introduce minor key songs.

Lovely | Willow | Moonlight Sonata | Take Me Home Country Roads

07 Rhythm and 7th Chords

Rhythm patterns and richer chord voicings: Cmaj7, G7, Fmaj7, Am7. Everything starts to sound fuller.

Imagine | With or Without You | A Thousand Years

08 Putting It All Together

Learn a few more songs, practice transitioning between keys, and bring everything together. A proper send-off.

Student choice from the full playlist

What You Need

- **A keyboard or piano**
Anything with at least 2 octaves. A mini keyboard, digital piano, upright, or grand piano all work perfectly fine.
- **Reliable internet**
Stable enough for a smooth one-hour video call once a week.
- **Your preferred video app**
We use Zoom, FaceTime, WhatsApp Video, or Facebook Messenger, whichever works best for your group.
- **A little practice time**
Even 10 to 15 minutes a few times a week between sessions makes a real difference.
