Juneteenth is the oldest African American celebration commemorating the end of slavery in the United States. The day celebrates when Union Soldiers, led by Major General Gordon Granger landed in Galveston, Texas on June 19, 1865, with the news that the war had ended and all slaves were free. This was two years after President Abraham Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation of 1863, freeing all slaves. The first Juneteenth celebration began on June 19, 1866, in Galveston, Texas. President Biden recognized Juneteenth as a federal holiday when he signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act on June 17, 2021.
