



## Centre Update - Re-Opening Status

The Ontario government, has now released its Roadmap to Reopen, a three-step plan to safely and cautiously reopen the province. In this plan it shows that we can reopen during Step One. It states that under Step One - "Sensory deprivation pods permitted when prescribed by a regulated health professional".

This means we can re-open as long as everyone who is floating has been prescribed floating by Regulated Health Professional (Nurse, Doctor, Chiropractor, Physiotherapists, Massage Therapist, Therapist, Psychologist, Social Worker etc.)

We are not taking any appointments yet but will be sending out an email/social media post as soon as we do. Until then we patiently await our return and look forward to seeing everyone again soon!


Each customer is therefore required to provide a Regulated Health Professional Note prior to floating while under Step One of Re-opening.

All Notes Must Have

- 1. Professional Letterhead
- 2. Prescription/Recommendation for Floating
- 3. Registration Number (To Show they are supported by RHPA)
