


Notice of Election of Municipal Officers

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, August 26, 2025, an election for the purpose of electing a Mayor and a Councilmember for each district on the Council: District 1; District 2; District 3; District 4 and District 5; for Reform, Alabama, will be held, and that all registered and qualified electors of the state, who reside within the corporate limits of Reform, Alabama, and have resided therein for 30 days or more immediately preceding the date of the election, and who are qualified to vote in the county precinct which embraces and covers that part of the corporate limits of Reform in which the elector resides, will be authorized to participate in the election. Any run-off election required will be held on Tuesday, September 23, 2025.


The polls will be opened at 7:00 a.m. and remain open continuously until 7:00 p.m. at the Reform Senior Activity Center located at 213 7th Avenue SW, Reform, Alabama.

Any qualified elector who will have resided within the district from which he or she seeks election, for a period of at least 90 days on August 26, 2025 may qualify to run for office by filing the appropriate forms and paying appropriate fee of \$50.00 which is set by Ordinance #052025, as otherwise provided by law will be accepted by the City Clerk between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. from June 10th to June 24th and until 5:00 p.m. on June 24th.
