

## ORDINANCE NO. 2026-1

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REFORM, ALABAMA, CHAPTER 17 – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, SECTION 1-9, AUTHORIZED HOURS, TO ALLOW THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ON-PREMISES AND OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION ON SUNDAYS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REFORM, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

#### SECTION 1. AMENDMENT

Chapter 17, Alcoholic Beverages, Section 1-9, “Authorized Hours,” of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Reform, Alabama, is hereby **amended** to read as follows:

##### **Sec. 1-9. Authorized Hours**

###### **(a) Monday through Saturday:**

It shall be unlawful for any person, whether a liquor, wine, or beer licensee or not, to sell, offer for sale, serve, dispense, or offer for reward any alcoholic beverages for on-premises or off-premises consumption between the hours of 12:00 a.m. (midnight) and 8:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

###### **(b) Sunday Sales Permitted:**

Notwithstanding any provision of this Code to the contrary, it shall be lawful for any person or establishment properly licensed to sell alcoholic beverages within the City of Reform to sell, offer for sale, serve, or dispense alcoholic beverages for on-premises and off-premises consumption only on Sundays between the hours of:

**12:00 p.m. (noon) and 12:00 a.m. (midnight)**

###### **(c) Sunday Restrictions:**

It shall be unlawful to sell, serve, or dispense alcoholic beverages on Sundays outside of the hours authorized herein.

###### **(d) Compliance with State Law:**

All sales, service, and distribution of alcoholic beverages shall remain subject to applicable laws, rules, and regulations of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and the State of Alabama.

#### SECTION 2. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY**

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE**


This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
