

Hearing Audiometry Test

INSTRUCTIONS FOR EMPLOYEES



1 Appointment Confirmation

Ensure you have received confirmation of your hearing audiometry test appointment. Note the date, time, and location of the appointment.



2 Arrive on Time

Arrive at the testing location at least 10 minutes before your scheduled appointment.



3 What to Bring

Bring your ID or any employee identification with photo.



4 Dress Comfortably

Wear comfortable clothing, as you will be required to sit still for the duration of the test.



REMINDER

Remember, the hearing audiometry test is conducted to screen for hearing deficits accurately, so it's important to follow these instructions carefully. If you have any concerns or questions before or after the test, don't hesitate to reach out to your supervisor or the testing personnel for assistance.

5 Avoid Loud Noises

Refrain from exposure to loud noises (e.g., concerts, loud music, machinery) at least 16 hours prior to the test.



6 Remove Obstructions

Ensure that your ears are free from any obstructions, such as wax buildup. If you suspect wax buildup, consider having your ears cleaned by a professional before the test.



7 Communicate Special Conditions

If you have any existing ear conditions or hearing issues, declare on the questionnaire, and inform the testing personnel before the test begins.



8 Relax and Stay Still

During the test, remain seated and avoid unnecessary movement. Please let the testing staff know that you are claustrophobic (afraid of confined spaces).



9 Follow Instructions & be kind to the clinic team

Listen carefully to the instructions provided by the testing personnel. They are there to help you.



10 Respond to Tones and Be Gentle with Our Equipment

You will be required to respond by pressing a button when you hear a tone. All our equipment complies with the industry standards. Please be gentle when handling all our equipment.



11 Note Any Discomfort

If you experience any discomfort during the test, inform the testing personnel immediately.



12 Be Honest

Provide honest feedback about what you hear. Do not try to guess if you are unsure.



13 Follow-Up Recommendations

If further action or follow-up or review by doctor is recommended based on the results, ensure that you follow the advice provided by the testing personnel.



14 Ask Questions

Feel free to ask any questions or seek clarification if needed.



15 Post-Test Instructions

Please wait to be released by the testing personnel before leaving the premises.
