Water affects surgical glue & incision. opens the causing infection.

What you see today is normal. Check twice a day for redness, swelling or discharge.

(The small, green tattoo indicates spayed or neutered.)

Open It is normal to see swelling & red discharge for a few days during the healing process.

Separate Animals

Keep females away from un-neutered males.

Restrict **Activity**

Inside rest gives the tissue time to heal & helps the incision stay closed.

(No running, jumping, or playing.)

Feed a Simple Diet

Do not give your pet junk food, special treats, table scraps or milk.
