


Quilt Top Kit Four Patch Quilt – QuiltedLove.org

Fabric Needed:



- 1 Yard of focus fabric
 - Sub cut into 15 – 6 ½“ squares
 - Sub cut into 4 – 3 ½” strips (outer border)
- 3 – 3 1/2” strips of fabric A (11 inches of fabric)
- 3 – 3 1/2” strips of fabric B (11 inches of fabric)
- 4 – 1 ½” strips of Inner Border Fabric (6 inches of fabric)

Assembling the Blocks: Use a ¼” seam allowance.

1. Sew one A strip and one B strip together to make a strip set as shown below. Press toward the darker fabric. Make 3 sets.



2. Cut strip sets into 30 units that measure 3 ½” x 6 ½”. Sew these units together to create 15 four-patch blocks that will measure 6 ½” square. Trim if needed.



Assembling the Quilt:

1. After the four-patch blocks are assembled, lay out your blocks alternating them with the 6 ½” focus fabric blocks in a checkerboard pattern.
2. Sew the blocks in each row together.
3. Sew rows together.
4. Add the side inner borders first. Then add the top and bottom inner borders.
5. Add your outer borders, first adding the side borders and then adding the top and bottom borders.

DOUBLE CHECK your seams to make sure they don't come apart. Trim threads. Make sure all pins are removed.
