Triple Friendship Star Quilt

Fabric Needed:

Yellow - 31"

White – 21"

Light Blue – 3.5"

Dark blue- 10"

Black – 10"

Instructions:

Yellow 7" WOF – cut into 6 - 7" squares

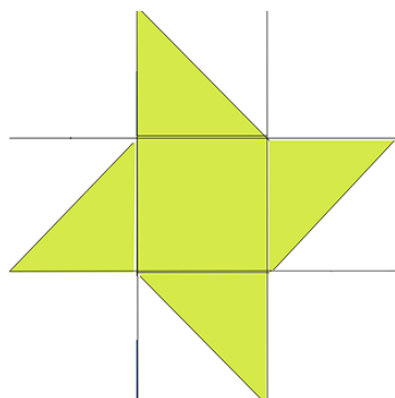
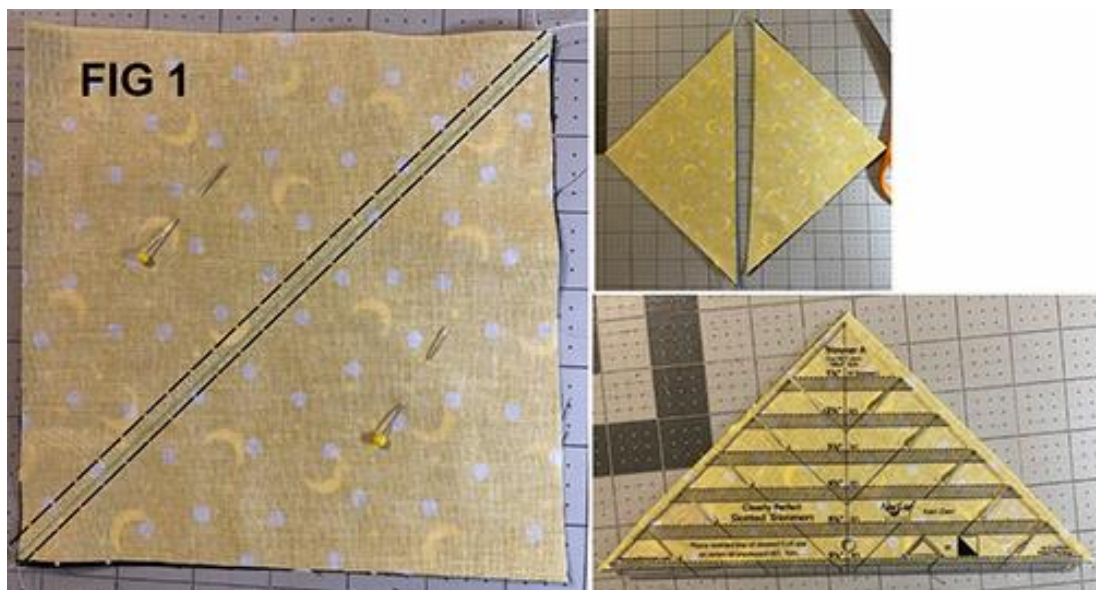
White: 7" WOF – cut into 6 - 7" squares

Place yellow and white fabric with right sides together.

Draw a line, corner to corner on your fabric.

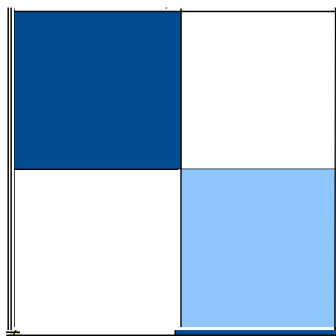
Sew ¼" seam allowance on each side of the line (see fig 1)

Cut in half following your drawn line. Press your seam and square these pieces to be 6-1/2" square.



Cut 6-1/2" WOF, cut into 6-1/2" squares. (This will be your stars center)

Lay out your stars as shown.



Make Nine 4 Patches (FIG 4)

- Cut 3-1/2" WOF of 3 different fabrics: 2 Strips of white, 1 dark blue, 1 light blue.
- Make 2 strip sets- white and dark blue / white and light blue.
- Sew, right sides together, with a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams.
- Cut both strip sets into 3-1/2" pieces.
- Sew one of each strip set together to make your 4-patch block. You'll need (11) 4-patch blocks.

-Cut WHITE 6-1/2" WOF. Cut into 6-1/2" squares. (You need 5)

-Cut dark blue 6-1/2" WOF. Cut into 6-1/2" squares. (You need 4)

-Lay out your pieces as shown in photo on page one.

-Sew the blocks in each row and then sew rows together.

Borders: Inside border – Black – Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips. Sew onto quilt top.

Outer Border – Yellow – Cut (5) 3.5" strips. Sew onto quilt top.
