Dual Friendship Star Quilt

Fabric Needed:

Yellow 7" Moon: 17"

Black Bubble: 9.5" WOF (four patch plus border) Earth and Clouds: 3.5" (Four patch blocks)

Stars: 3.5" (4 patch blocks)

Black with Specks: 15" (4 patch blocks plus border)

4 Different coordinating fabrics 3-1/2" WOF Black Scroll – cut 3 pieces 6-1/2" WOF, cut into 6-1/2" squares

Instructions:


Yellow 7" WOF – cut into 4 7" squares Moon: 7" WOF – cut into 4 7" squares

Place yellow and moon fabric with right sides together.

Draw a line, corner to corner on your fabric.

Sew ¼" seam allowance on each side of the line (see fig 1)

Cut in ½, press your seam and square these pieces to be 6-1/2" square





Cut left over yellow 7" strip into 2 – 6-1/2" squares

Lay out your stars as shown (fig 2)



Make Nine 4 Patches (FIG 4)

Cut 3-1/2" WOF of 4 different fabrics; I used earth, black bubbles, stars and black specks.

Press seams.

Cut both strip sets into 3-1/2" pieces.

Sew one of each strip set together to make your 4-patch block. You'll need nine 4-patch blocks.

- -Cut 15 6-1/2" squares
- -Lay out your pieces as shown in photo on page one.
- -Sew the blocks in each row and then sew rows together.

Borders: Inside border – Black Bubble – Cut 4 1-1/2" strips. Sew onto quilt top. Middle Border – Moons – cut 4 2-1/2" strips. Sew onto quilt top. Outer Border – Yellow – Cut 5 2-1/4" strips. Sew onto quilt top.
