

# Support for Our Friends in Murang'a County, Kenya

## Introduction

Many families and farmers in Murang'a County face challenges in accessing essential resources for food security and sustainable agriculture. This plan aims to provide much-needed support by supplying fertilizer, food assistance, and maize seedlings to improve their livelihoods and enhance agricultural productivity.

**Below is the detailed plan:**

### 1. Fertilizer Support for Maize Farmers

- Beneficiaries: 20 farmers
- Fertilizer Allocation: 10 kg per farmer
- Total Fertilizer Needed: 200 kg
- Cost per 50-kg Bag: KES 6,000 ( $\approx$  \$46.44)
- Total Number of Bags: 4
- Total Cost: KES 24,000 ( $\approx$  \$185.76)

### 2. Food Assistance for Families

- Beneficiaries: 20 families
  - Family Sizes: Some families have 8 members, while others have 4 members.
  - Food Duration: For families of 8, the food can last about 2 weeks, while for families of 4, it can last up to 3 weeks.
  - Assistance per Family: KES 3,500 ( $\approx$  \$27.07)
  - Total Cost: KES 70,000 ( $\approx$  \$541.80)

### 3. Maize “Corns” Seedlings Support

- Beneficiaries: 5 families who have not planted yet
- Total Packets Needed: 5
- Cost per Packet: KES 1,150 (≈ \$8.89)
- Total Cost: KES 5,750 (≈ \$44.45)
