Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God.

Romans 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Romans 12:18 If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.

Hebrews 12:14 Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord:

James 3:18 Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

2 Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord,

Psalms 34:14 Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.

Leviticus 19:5 'And if you offer a sacrifice of a peace offering to the Lord, you shall offer it of your own free will.

Numbers 6:26 The Lord lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace.'"

Deuteronomy 20:10 "When you go near a city to fight against it, then proclaim an offer of peace to it.

Joshua 9:15 So Joshua made peace with them, and made a covenant with them to let them live; and the rulers of the congregation swore to them.

Judges 6:23 Then the Lord said to him, "Peace be with you; do not fear, you shall not die."

Judges 6:24 So Gideon built an altar there to the Lord, and called it The-Lord-Is-Peace. To this day it is still in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

Judges 18:6 And the priest said to them, “Go in peace. The presence of the Lord be with you on your way.”

1 Samuel 1:17 Then Eli answered and said, “Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him.”

1 Samuel 10:27 But some rebels said, “How can this man save us?” So they despised him, and brought him no presents. But he held his peace.

1 Samuel 25:6 And thus you shall say to him who lives in prosperity: ‘Peace be to you, peace to your house, and peace to all that you have!’

1 Chronicles 12:18 Then the Spirit came upon Amasai, chief of the captains, and he said: “We are yours, O David; We are on your side, O son of Jesse! Peace, peace to you, And peace to your helpers! For your God helps you.” So David received them, and made them captains of the troop.

Job 22:21 “Now acquaint yourself with Him, and be at peace; Thereby good will come to you.

Job 33:33 If not, listen to me; Hold your peace, and I will teach you wisdom.”

Psalms 29:11 The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace.

Psalms 35:20 For they do not speak peace, But they devise deceitful matters Against the quiet ones in the land.

Psalms 37:11 But the meek shall inherit the earth, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.

Psalms 55:18 He has redeemed my soul in peace from the battle that was against me, For there were many against me.

Psalms 85:8 I will hear what God the Lord will speak, For He will speak peace To His people and to His saints; But let them not turn back to folly.

Psalms 85:10 Mercy and truth have met together; Righteousness and peace have kissed.

Psalm 119:165 Great peace have those who love Your law, And nothing causes them to stumble.

Psalm 120:6 My soul has dwelt too long With one who hates peace.

Proverbs 3:17 Her ways are ways of pleasantness, And all her paths are peace.

Proverbs 11:12 He who is devoid of wisdom despises his neighbor, But a man of understanding holds his peace.

Proverbs 12:20 Deceit is in the heart of those who devise evil, But counselors of peace have joy.

Proverbs 16:7 When a man's ways please the Lord, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him.

Proverbs 17:28 Even a fool is counted wise when he holds his peace; When he shuts his lips, he is considered perceptive.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 26:12 Lord, You will establish peace for us, For You have also done all our works in us.

Isaiah 27:5 Or let him take hold of My strength, That he may make peace with Me; And he shall make peace with Me.”

Isaiah 32:17 The work of righteousness will be peace, And the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever.

Isaiah 38:17 Indeed it was for my own peace That I had great bitterness; But You have lovingly delivered my soul from the pit of corruption, For You have cast all my sins behind Your back.

Isaiah 42:14 [Promise of the Lord's Help] “I have held My peace a long time, I have been still and restrained Myself. Now I will cry like a woman in labor, I will pant and gasp at once.

Isaiah 48:18 Oh, that you had heeded My commandments! Then your peace would have been like a river, And your righteousness like the waves of the sea.

Isaiah 59:8 The way of peace they have not known, And there is no justice in their ways; They have made themselves crooked paths; Whoever takes that way shall not know peace.

Jeremiah 9:8 Their tongue is an arrow shot out; It speaks deceit; One speaks peaceably to his neighbor with his mouth, But in his heart he lies in wait.

Jeremiah 33:6 Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.

Ezekiel 37:26 Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them, and it shall be an everlasting covenant with them; I will establish them and multiply them, and I will set My sanctuary in their midst forevermore.

Obadiah 1:7 All the men in your confederacy Shall force you to the border; The men at peace with you Shall deceive you and prevail against you. Those who eat your bread shall lay a trap for you. No one is aware of it.

Micah 3:5 Thus says the Lord concerning the prophets Who make my people stray; Who chant "Peace" While they chew with their teeth, But who prepare war against him Who puts nothing into their mouths:

Haggai 2:9 'The glory of this latter temple shall be greater than the former,' says the Lord of hosts. 'And in this place I will give peace,' says the Lord of hosts."

Zechariah 8:16 These are the things you shall do: Speak each man the truth to his neighbor; Give judgment in your gates for truth, justice, and peace;

Zechariah 8:19 "Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'The fast of the fourth month, The fast of the fifth, The fast of the seventh, And the fast of the tenth, Shall be joy and gladness and cheerful feasts For the house of Judah. Therefore love truth and peace.'

Matthew 10:13 If the household is worthy, let your peace come upon it. But if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you.

Matthew 10:34 [Christ Brings Division] “Do not think that I came to bring peace on earth. I did not come to bring peace but a sword.

Mark 5:34 And He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction.”

Mark 9:50 Salt is good, but if the salt loses its flavor, how will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace with one another.”

Luke 1:79 To give light to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, To guide our feet into the way of peace.”

Luke 2:14 “Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!”

Luke 10:6 And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you.

Luke 12:51 Do you suppose that I came to give peace on earth? I tell you, not at all, but rather division.

Luke 19:38 saying: “ ‘Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!’ Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!”

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”

John 20:21 So Jesus said to them again, “Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you.”

Acts 10:36 The word which God sent to the children of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ—He is Lord of all

Romans 1:7 To all who are in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Romans 2:10 but glory, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Romans 3:17 And the way of peace they have not known.”

Romans 5:1 [Faith Triumphs in Trouble] Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

Romans 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Romans 14:19 Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another.

Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Romans 15:33 Now the God of peace be with you all. Amen.

Romans 16:20 And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

1 Corinthians 1:3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 7:15 But if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases. But God has called us to peace.

1 Corinthians 14:33 For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.

2 Corinthians 13:11 [Greetings and Benediction] Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.

Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Ephesians 2:17 And He came and preached peace to you who were afar off and to those who were near.

Ephesians 4:3 endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Ephesians 6:23 Peace to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 4:7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:9 The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.

Colossians 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.

Thessalonians 5:23 [Blessing and Admonition] Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Thessalonians 3:16 [Benediction] Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you peace always in every way. The Lord be with you all.

2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

Titus 3:2 to speak evil of no one, to be peaceable, gentle, showing all humility to all men.

James 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

1 Peter 3:11 Let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it.

1 Peter 5:14 Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace to you all who are in Christ Jesus. Amen.

2 Peter 3:14 [Be Steadfast] Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless;

Jude 1:2 Mercy, peace, and love be multiplied to you.
