

## Forget, forgot

Deuteronomy 26:13 I have not transgressed Your commandments, nor have I forgotten them.

Deuteronomy 31:21 for it will not be forgotten in the mouths of their descendants,

Deuteronomy 32:18 Of the Rock who begot you, you are unmindful, And have forgotten the God who fathered you.

Judges 3:7 So the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord. They forgot the Lord their God, and served the Baals and Asherahs.

1 Samuel 12:9 And when they forgot the Lord their God, He sold them into the hand of Sisera,

Job 19:14 My relatives have failed, And my close friends have forgotten me.

Job 28:3 He breaks open a shaft away from people; In places forgotten by feet They hang far away from men; They swing to and fro.

Psalms 9:18 For the needy shall not always be forgotten; The expectation of the poor shall not perish forever.

Psalms 44:17 All this has come upon us; But we have not forgotten You, Nor have we dealt falsely with Your covenant.

Psalms 44:20 If we had forgotten the name of our God, Or stretched out our hands to a foreign god,

Psalms 78:11 And forgot His works And His wonders that He had shown them.

Psalms 106:13 They soon forgot His works; They did not wait for His counsel,

Psalms 106:21 They forgot God their Savior, Who had done great things in Egypt,

Psalms 119:61 The cords of the wicked have bound me, But I have not forgotten Your law.

Psalms 119:139 My zeal has consumed me, Because my enemies have forgotten Your words.

Ecclesiastes 2:16 For there is no more remembrance of the wise than of the fool forever, Since all that now is will be forgotten in the days to come. And how does a wise man die? As the fool!

Isaiah 17:10 Because you have forgotten the God of your salvation, And have not been mindful of the Rock of your stronghold,

Jeremiah 2:32 Can a virgin forget her ornaments, Or a bride her attire? Yet My people have forgotten Me days without number.

Jeremiah 3:21 A voice was heard on the desolate heights, Weeping and supplications of the children of Israel. For they have perverted their way; They have forgotten the Lord their God.

Jeremiah 13:25 This is your lot, The portion of your measures from Me,” says the Lord, “Because you have forgotten Me And trusted in falsehood.

Jeremiah 18:15 “Because My people have forgotten Me, They have burned incense to worthless idols. And they have caused themselves to stumble in their ways, From the ancient paths, To walk in pathways and not on a highway,

Jeremiah 23:27 as their fathers forgot My name for Baal.

Jeremiah 23:40 And I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual shame, which shall not be forgotten.’

Jeremiah 44:9 Have you forgotten the wickedness of your fathers, the wickedness of the kings of Judah, the wickedness of their wives, your own wickedness, and the wickedness of your wives, which they committed in the land of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem?

Jeremiah 50:6 “My people have been lost sheep. Their shepherds have led them astray; They have turned them away on the mountains. They have gone from mountain to hill; They have forgotten their resting place.

Lamentations 3:17 You have moved my soul far from peace; I have forgotten prosperity.

Ezekiel 22:12 In you they take bribes to shed blood; you take usury and increase; you have made profit from your neighbors by extortion, and have forgotten Me,” says the Lord God.

Ezekiel 23:35 “Therefore thus says the Lord God: ‘Because you have forgotten Me and cast Me behind your back, Therefore you shall bear the penalty Of your lewdness and your harlotry.’ ”

Hosea 2:13 I will punish her For the days of the Baals to which she burned incense. She decked herself with her earrings and jewelry, And went after her lovers; But Me she forgot,” says the Lord.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.

Hosea 8:14 “For Israel has forgotten his Maker, And has built temples; Judah also has multiplied fortified cities; But I will send fire upon his cities, And it shall devour his palaces.”

Hosea 13:6 When they had pasture, they were filled; They were filled and their heart was exalted; Therefore they forgot Me.

2 Peter 1:9 For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

Forget

Deuteronomy 4:9 Only take heed to yourself, and diligently keep yourself, lest you forget the things your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. And teach them to your children and your grandchildren,

Deuteronomy 4:23 Take heed to yourselves, lest you forget the covenant of the Lord your God which He made with you, and make for yourselves a carved image in the form of anything which the Lord your God has forbidden you.

Deuteronomy 6:12 then beware, lest you forget the Lord who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

Deuteronomy 8:11 “Beware that you do not forget the Lord your God by not keeping His commandments, His judgments, and His statutes which I command you today,

Deuteronomy 8:14 when your heart is lifted up, and you forget the Lord your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage;

Deuteronomy 8:19 Then it shall be, if you by any means forget the Lord your God, and follow other gods, and serve them and worship them, I testify against you this day that you shall surely perish.

Deuteronomy 9:7 “Remember! Do not forget how you provoked the Lord your God to wrath in the wilderness. From the day that you departed from the land of Egypt until you came to this place, you have been rebellious against the Lord.

Deuteronomy 25:19 Therefore it shall be, when the Lord your God has given you rest from your enemies all around, in the land which the Lord your God is giving you to possess as an inheritance, that you will blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven. You shall not forget.

2 Kings 17:38 And the covenant that I have made with you, you shall not forget, nor shall you fear other gods.

Job 8:13 So are the paths of all who forget God; And the hope of the hypocrite shall perish,

Job 11:16 Because you would forget your misery, And remember it as waters that have passed away,

Job 39:15 She forgets that a foot may crush them, Or that a wild beast may break them.

Psalms 9:17 The wicked shall be turned into hell, And all the nations that forget God.

Psalms 50:22 “Now consider this, you who forget God, Lest I tear you in pieces, And there be none to deliver:

59:11 Do not slay them, lest my people forget; Scatter them by Your power, And bring them down, O Lord our shield.

78:7 That they may set their hope in God, And not forget the works of God,  
But keep His commandments;

88:12 Shall Your wonders be known in the dark? And Your righteousness in  
the land of forgetfulness?

103:2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits:

119:16 I will delight myself in Your statutes; I will not forget Your word.

119:83 For I have become like a wineskin in smoke, Yet I do not forget Your  
statutes.

119:93 I will never forget Your precepts, For by them You have given me life.

119:109 My life is continually in my hand, Yet I do not forget Your law.

119:76 I have gone astray like a lost sheep; Seek Your servant, For I do not  
forget Your commandments.

Proverbs 2:17 Who forsakes the companion of her youth, And forgets the  
covenant of her God.

Proverbs 3:1 My son, do not forget my law, But let your heart keep my  
commands;

Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom! Get understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away  
from the words of my mouth.

Proverbs 31:5 Lest they drink and forget the law, And pervert the justice of all  
the afflicted.

Isaiah 51:13 And you forget the Lord your Maker,

65:11 But you are those who forsake the Lord, Who forget My holy mountain,  
Who prepare a table for Gad, And who furnish a drink offering for Meni.

Philippians 3:13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but  
one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching  
forward to those things which are ahead,

Hebrews 6:10 For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love  
which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the  
saints, and do minister.

Hebrews 13:2 Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have  
unwittingly entertained angels.

Hebrews 13:16 But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such  
sacrifices God is well pleased.

James 1:24 for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what  
kind of man he was.

James 1:25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it,  
and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in  
what he does.

2 Peter 3:5 For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens  
were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water,

2 Peter 3:8 But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.
