Accordingly, the Hebrew word nephesh, although translated as "soul" in some older English Bibles, actually has a meaning closer to "living being"... "to breathe, blow" which is the root of the English words "psyche," "psychology") – soul (psyche); a person's distinct identity

Psuche is translated 104 times with 36 used as soul

According to the biblical passages below:

The Soul can seek, sleep, grow weary, rejoice, sin, feed, desire, die, love, serve, feel longing and sorrow.

The Soul can be rich, destroyed, overwhelmed, troubled, empty, not satisfied, not upright, discouraged, revived, forfeited, exchanged, converted, delivered, and redeemed.
