Thank you for downloading the Print & Play edition of Bull of Wall Street!

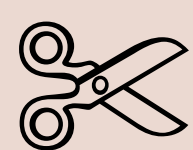
--Follow these simple steps to bring the game to life at home--



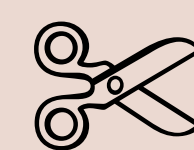
## Printing



- **Paper:** Standard A4 or US Letter works. Cardstock is best for durability, but regular paper is fine.
- **Color:** Full color recommended for the best look, but black & white will still play just as well.
- **Scaling:** Print at 100% (Actual Size) so the cards match the correct dimensions.



## Cutting



- Each sheet has **red dotted lines**.
- Cut along the **red dotted lines** to separate the cards, cash, and other components.
- For neat edges, use a paper cutter or scissors carefully.

## Cash Sheets



- You'll find one page for each cash denomination.
  - Print **as many copies** as you need to match the number of players in your game.
  - We recommend printing a few extras so no one runs out of money mid-game!
- \*Quantity in real game:** 40\*(5 Bullite), 40\*(20 Bullite), 50\*(50 Bullite), 50\*(100 Bullite), 12\*(500 Bullite)



## Get Ready to Play



- After cutting and preparing your pieces, open the Rules & Gameplay Guide included in this download.
- Shuffle the cards, distribute the cash, and you're ready to start trading, investing, and battling market swings!

# Extra Tips



## Tips to Enhance your Game

- Use **thicker paper** or **cardstock** for cards and cash to make them feel more like real game pieces.
- **Sleeve or laminate** the cards if you want them to last longer, especially if you'll be playing often.
- **Print extra cash** pages—it's better to have more money than to run out in the middle of a trade!
- **Glue cards onto index cards** or **cardboard** if you don't have cardstock for extra durability.
- **Store pieces in ziplock bags** or **envelopes** so setup is quick and nothing gets lost between games.
