

Best Practices for Google Photos

- 1. Guides are to <u>only use school devices</u> (ipad/iphone) to take pictures of learners and learning evidence.
- 2. Photos are to be uploaded **DAILY** to your Studio's Google Photo Album

- 3. Only photos that can be used for learning evidence should be uploaded to the Google Photos Album
 - o This includes:
 - Photo of learner(s) engaged in a specific task/activity
 - Photo of learner work
 - This does not include
 - Portraits of learner(s)
 - Photos of learner(s) on playground
 - Avoid uploading duplicate or similar photos.
- 4. Each photo must have a **comment attached** to it with the following information.
 - Title of Activity (e.g. Quest Jar Experiment)
 - Learning Target(s) of Activity (e.g. counting by 5s; counting to 100)
 - Level of Competency (1-4) for each Target
 - If there are multiple learners please provide only one learning target and assessment for all learners
 - List each learner's name with level of competency
 Write a sentence (e.g. "All learners were a 3 except _____ and ____ who were a 2"

How to input photos into Google Photos Albums

- 1. Click on the bookmarked safari page on your device's home screen.
- 2. Click on your Studio's Album
- 3. Click "Add Photos"
- 4. Select Photos to add; Click "Add"
- 5. To make a comment click on individual photo and click "Comment"
