<u>ONE TIME SHOW CREDIT</u>: (members only) If you need to cancel your show entry and you do so on or before the Tuesday before the show date you will be issued a show credit for your classes (one per person one per season) to use only at the next show. This is only for members that are in good standing & not for office fees. There are no refunds of show entry fees. Non-members will not receive credit or refund of any kind.

Please fill out the show entry completely. One horse & rider per form, Entries sent without full payment (i.e. scanned email entries) will not be scheduled until payment is received.

Non-Competing Horses are welcome, but must fill out entry form with Coggins and pay the office fee.

<u>Make checks payable to:</u> SWFDA and *mail to* the Show Secretary: Checks should be only for show entry fees. Do not include other fees like membership dues, etc.

DRESS CODE: Riding jackets are optional. Breeches may be light or dark colored. Shirts must have a collar with short or long sleeves. Please no sleeveless shirts, tank tops, or t-shirts. Appropriate footwear is required (ie tall boots, paddock boots, etc)

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: <u>SWFDA insurance requires protective headgear for ALL levels and ALL disciplines,</u> <u>including Western Dressage.</u> Anyone on a horse at any time, including schooling, must wear a helmet.

RULES: USEF Rules are used as a guideline. Exceptions will be made with approval from the grievance committee prior to competing. Non-USEF equipment in either the warm-up or competition ring will always require prior approval and the necessity of riding H.C.

TRAILER PARKING, LOADING, & UNLOADING: Please park in designated parking areas.

COGGINS TEST: COPY OF CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES. The horse's name must match with show entry. or you will need to submit an authorized letter from your vet verifying the

horse is the same as on Coggins. Once Coggins has been submitted, it will be kept on file and you will not need to submit again for the show season.

POST ENTRIES: Will be accepted if the show is not full. These will be on a first come, first serve basis. These must be received by mail (or Venmo) with an additional \$20.00 post entry fee. Fee MUST accompany entry or it will not be accepted.

RIDE TIMES: Notification is by e-mail. Please include your legible email address on entry form.

AWARDS: Ribbons 1st through 6th place. High Point Award to highest single score per declared status. (Must have a minimum of 3 competitors per declared status for High Point) In the spirit of sportsmanship, community & support of fellow riders, a High Point Award will be awarded a maximum of 2 times per rider in the show season. After any rider has been awarded High Point for a total of two shows, the High Point for that declared status will be awarded to the next highest score of the day.

FOOTING: The Arena was constructed with 6 inches of white clay as a base and then 4 and 1/2 inches of screenings over the top.

STABLING: Limited, first come basis., and include inside stalls as well as small turnouts with a covering.

CONCESSION: There is no promise of concessions on site, however, a charity typically offers lunch items for a donation.SWFDA will have water available while supplies last. (bring your own snacks/beverages as needed)

DIRECTIONS: Hidden Haven: 10851 Deal Road, N Ft Myers 33917. Off I-75 take exit 143 on to SR78, Bayshore Road toward Pine Island Rd. Keep Right on Bayshore East. In 2.1 miles turn Left onto Palm Creek Drive. In 1.5 miles turn Left onto Deal Road. In 900 feet turn Right to property.

ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING OR VAPING ALLOWED NEAR COMPETITION OR WARM UP AREAS. You will be asked to move from the area.

Spectators are allowed, please bring your own chairs and be respectful of riders in the show ring.

NO DOGS ALLOWED. SWFDA insurance prohibits dogs on the competition grounds.
