- (3) Keeler. Phil Fournier was hired at \$25.00 for three days work with his horse and tractor.
- In 3 days, the men processed 97 logs. 7 – 14 in. in diameter by 40 – 50 ft. long. The logs were trimmed, stacked, and covered for the winter.
- In 1952 for three Saturdays, June 16, 23, and 30th, Clifford Wilson's truck brought all of the logs back to Eaton Rapids.
- In December 1952, membership was 405. Money was raised by selling the logs for \$10.00 donation in which one log can have many buyers who could carve their name on it.

Membership

- Annual dues are \$60.00 for the family, (Family defined as the member and spouse and those under 18 living in the same household accompanied by a responsible adult). Senior citizens \$45.00, (those 65 years old or older are given a discount of \$15.00.) You are allowed to bring 2 guests when visiting the range that are not immediate family.

Benefits of Membership

1. We offer 5, 15, 25, 50, and 100-yard backstops for a variety of shooting.

3. After 90 days of Membership the Clubhouse may be rented by a member at a reduced rate. Clubhouse rental gives members the opportunity to use the hall for family gatherings, parties, or picnics. The facility includes the kitchen, pavilion, grill and yard. It does not include the shooting range.
