

Nearly 30 years ago, one of the first Christ-centered surf documentary films, ***Changes***, premiered at the La Paloma Theatre in Encinitas. By God's grace, my wife, Judy, and I were part of that effort with Bryan Jennings and Ed Feuer. The latter half of ***Changes*** featured the Chris O'Rourke story—created and filmed by Ed—probably the most Holy Spirit-anointed segment of any of the twelve films produced by Walking on Water.

God harvested a lot of fruit globally through ***Changes***. By His grace and answered prayer, from 1995-2018, Walking on Water: produced 12 faith-based surf movies and translated these movies into over a dozen languages. Approximately 500,000 people attended live global screenings of Walking on Water movies and millions heard the gospel through movies and outreach events!

Again, by God's grace, we're involved with Ed in the production of ***Changes 2***, a film we pray will again have a global impact for His glory. Our prayer is to premier ***Changes 2*** this spring at the La Paloma Theatre in Encinitas. Most of the film interviews are completed, including interviews with: Felipe Toledo (2X world champion); Eric Arakawa (renown surfboard builder); Erin Brooks (who recently won the 2024 Vans Pipe Masters Women's Final—the youngest winner in the event's history at the age of 17); Bethany Hamilton (who mentored Erin Brooks); world renown surf photographer Aaron Chang; and the high flying Australian surfer Reef Heazlewood. Ed Feuer and his production team are busy now with the final editing. This is a Gospel-centered production that will not only reach the lost but serve to reconcile broken marriages and heal dysfunctional families. By God's grace, ***Changes 2*** will have a global impact on surfers and non-surfers alike.
