Flea Control

Dawn soap (blue) Kills live fleas, it does not kill eggs
Capstar – Nitenprym 11.4 mg oral will kill fleas with in 10 min. Contact Jennifer for Dose to give
Revolution – topical Rx required kills fleas and mites and many worms. Once a month application
Advantage – topical flea **NOT** for use on kittens less than 8 wks or 2 lbs. Once a month topical
Program – Lufenuron oral once a month flea med.

WORMER

Kittens 2wks -8wks Strongid every 14 days until 8 week spay apt.
Kittens 8 wks and older can receive Drontal 2 times 4wks apart
