

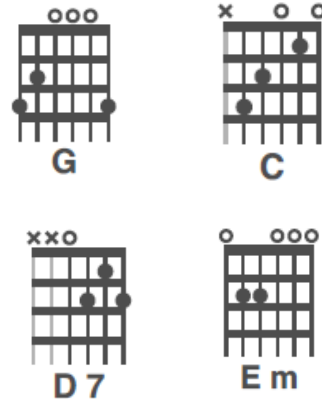
# Blowin' in the Wind
