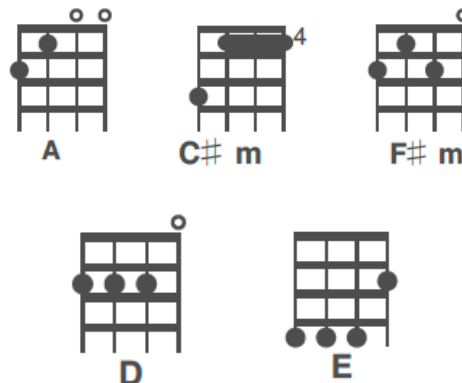

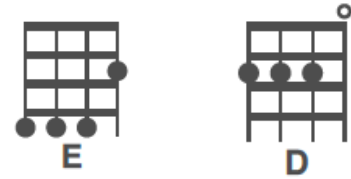
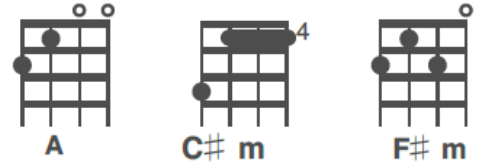
VERSE 4:
