Weekly Art for Wellbeing Sessions

Peace by Piece Art provides weekly Saturday art sessions held at Perth City Farm. These sessions offer structured, peer-led and self-guided art making opportunities with the aim to support and improve mental wellbeing, skill development and social connection.

We offer multiple types of art sessions including;

- Painting/Mixed Media
- Sashiko Stitching
- Quilling
- Bring Your Own

- Kintsugi
- Charcoal Drawing
- Printmaking

We aim to have these sessions at an affordable price to ensure they are accessible and inclusive to all community members where they can engage in creative expression on a regular basis.



Specialist Art for Wellbeing Workshops

PBP in partnership with The Hundred Pilates Studio in Scarborough held a series of HeArt Space at The Hundred workshops which included art therapy, a guided breathworks session and a cacao ceremony.

These workshops focused on supporting mental health and wellbeing while offering a safe and creative space for participants to express themselves, relax, and connect with others.

Each HeArt Space workshop explored different themes including inner peace, self-care and self-love. Our guided breathworks session were delivered by Amber from Healing Hearts.

Through the power of art, we aimed to promote mindfulness, build confidence, and encourage positive emotional healing within our community.

We believe that healing happens through connection — with ourselves, with others, and with creative expression.

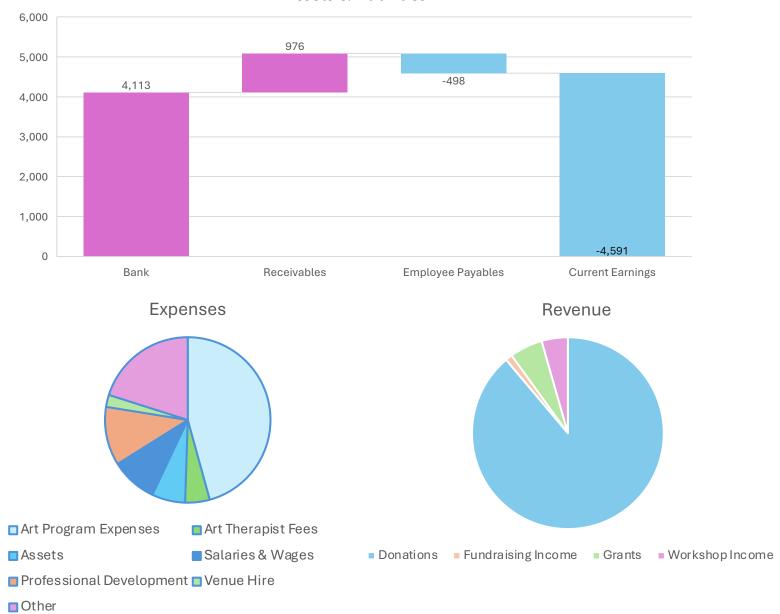

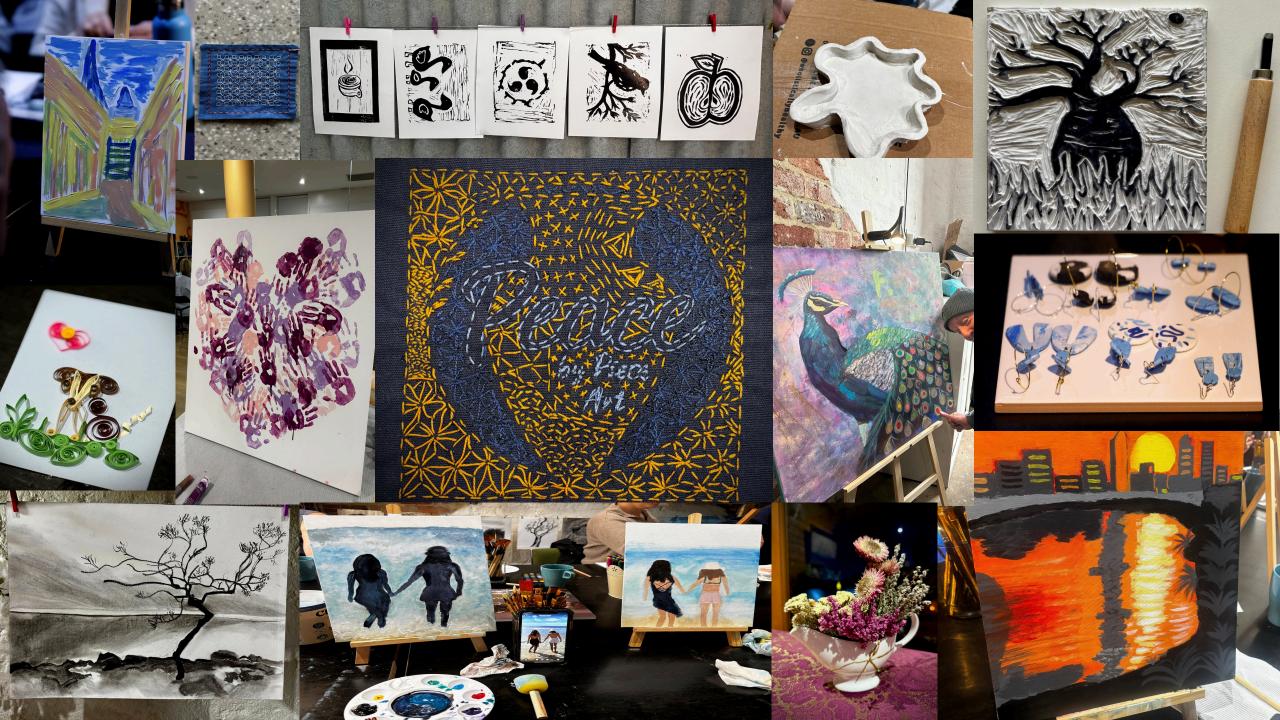
