Coming on the heels of <u>Netflix's "The Roast of Tom Brady,"</u> which had social media abuzz with jokes aimed at the former <u>NFL star</u>, the roast was fodder for a recent conversation between <u>Jason Kelce and his brother Travis</u>.

Meanwhile, Travis chimed in with his own list of people he'd be comfortable with aiming endless jabs at him for a night. One seemingly was Andrew Santino, who recently appeared on "New Heights."

"Well, Santino's one of my favorite comedians of all time and I think he would [expletive] deliver," he said.

"Dave Chappelle is the all-time great. Kevin Hart. I would love Kevin to go up there and just [expletive] rip me in half," Travis continued before he praised Hart for hosting Brady's roast.

Travis Kelce also mentioned Nikki Glaser, who also did a stellar job during Brady's roast.

"Nikki Glaser's [expletive] hilarious. If I did a roast, you would have to get Nikki up there," Travis continued, rattling names off his list.

There was a moment during the roast that Travis highlighted, where well-known roaster Jeff Ross told a joke that seemed to have bothered Brady a bit, from what it looked like to viewers at least.

"I met Jeff Ross out in L.A. at one of the Comedy Stores out there," he said. "Yeah, he actually hosts roast battles between comics and I was able to kind of be a part of and judge one of them and had a [expletive] blast with him," he said. "So it'd be an honor to get roasted by Jeff but, yeah, maybe that day will come."

While Travis thought the Brady roast was "unbelievable," his brother's reaction was a bit more reserved.

"It was pure entertainment and I'm really happy they did it, but I just do not get the roasts. I don't understand why people do them. Maybe I take myself too seriously," Jason said.

The huge turnout is what stuck with him the most.

"The best part about it was how many iconic NFL and celebrities, just of immense stature that were there. Not to mention just the entire Patriots dynasty showed up for Tom," Jason Kelce said.
