On Sunday morning, BJP's national president JP Nadda met Union home minister Amit Shah at the latter's residence in Delhi. Sources told ET that apart from usual business, the two leaders discussed the activities which could take place in the coming few days in Delhi.

Meanwhile, the newly-elected 48 MLAs of the party spent their day meeting and greeting people from their constituencies. Some of the newly-elected MLAs also met Lieutenant Governor of Delhi VK Saxena. New Delhi MLA Parvesh Verma, who defeated Arvind Kejriwal, was the first one to pay a vi-

sit to the LG, followed by other leaders like Kailash Gahlot and Arvinder Singh Lovely. Lovely called it a courtesy meeting post the party's victory in Delhi.

In his victory speech, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had on Saturday announced that the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) report regarding "corruption" in Delhi will soon be tabled in the assembly and action will be taken against those who were involved in corruption. Since then every BJP leader has been reiterating it as a priority for the government. "The people of Delhi have rejected Arvind Kejriwal. Now the time has come to punish him for his deeds... He has done corruption, that is why the PM had said that the CAG report will be presented..." Harish Khurana, the newly-elected party MLA from Moti Nagar constituency told ET.

As per party sources, the swearing-in ceremony will only take place after Prime Minister Modi comes back from his France and US visit.

New Delhi: A special CBI court has asked all the accused involved in the Delhi excise case to conclude inspection of documents not relied upon by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) "within a reasonable time" so that the trial in the high-profile political case can begin. "De-

INDIA Bloc 'Disintegrating Fast', Says Pradhan

Kolkata: Minister Dharma Pradhan on Sunday said that the INDIA bloc is "disintegrating fast" and its partners are facing defeat in different parts of the country as they do not have any common agenda.

Attending an event in Kolkata, Pradhan said after BJP's victory in Delhi, the party will form a government in West Bengal next. "21 states with governments have been running successfully with PM Narendra Modi as its captain," Pradhan said.

Pradhan said that in the Delhi polls, one INDIA bloc partner (AAP) has faced defeat after staying in power for 10 years, while other partner (Congress) has bitten the dust. "INDIA bloc is facing the contradictions of its constituents. The revolutionary has all but ceased to exist," he noted.

Pointing out that the victory of the BJP in the Delhi assembly polls is the assertion of the 'vikas' (development) policy by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Pradhan said, "It is the verdict of the residents of Delhi in favour of the BJP to transform the national capital into a beautiful city."

BJP won more than 26 years, winning 48 of the 70 assembly seats. The AAP won 22 seats while the Congress drew a blank in the polls held on February 5. — OPB

"On one side, there are 58% people and, on the other, 42%. It is the right of the 58% that the name should be changed accordingly. The name could be Shiv Vihar or Shiv Puri," he said. Delhi Setback to Tilt Balance of power for Cong towards South

Bengaluru: The Congress party's inability to win a single seat in the Delhi assembly polls — third time in a row — will lift the political weight of southern CMs — Siddaramaiah of Karnataka and Revanth Reddy of Telangana — while magnifying the losing appeal of the Delhi leadership.

The Delhi results will also give credence to the claims in political circles that the Congress' impressive haul of votes in the assembly polls in the two southern states was largely due to the influence of local leaders over and above the appeal of welfare guarantees, as well as other local factors.

In the north, the Congress rules only Himachal Pradesh on its own. The Delhi shocker comes on the back of its rout in Haryana and Maharashtra. Evidently, the loss in Delhi may even tilt the balance of power towards the South for the Congress. The party leadership may

not have the moral courage to preach the southern leaders on how to win polls or summon them to Delhi to take orders until the party delivers a decisive victory or two. In the South, the Congress has been in alliance with regional parties, including the DMK in Tamil Nadu and Indian Union Muslim League in Kerala. The two states are headed for assembly polls next year. "The two regional parties will play hardball while negotiating seat-sharing. The Congress will be at the mercy of regional leaders and under pressure to accept whatever comes its way," said S Suresh Kumar, BJP MLA in Bengaluru. The latest setback for the grand old party comes on the heels of AICC president Mallikarjuna Kharge's call to top leaders in Belagavi in December that they must actively fight the atmosphere of disappointment the Haryana and Maharashtra results have created.

Mission for clean technology:

A significant focus of the mission is on clean tech manufacturing, reinforcing India's commitment to climate-friendly industrial growth. The initiative will supplement the efforts already announced by the government to strengthen the domestic supply chains. Currently, local module manufacturing capacity of over 67 GW per year and cell manufacturing capacity of about 15 GW is available in the country. Further, wind energy technology has achieved 70-80% indigenisation with strong domestic manufacturing in the wind sector having a capacity of about 18 GW. However, domestic manufacturing of few wind turbine components are to be developed, which would be undertaken in the proposed mission. Green Hydrogen being an evolving sector will also benefit from the proposed mission.

vernment is also considering the launch of intra-state Green Energy Corridor Phase-II to enable seamless evacuation and grid integration of renewable energy from new and emerging Renewable Energy Zones. The Ministry of Power has set a deadline of March 31 for all states to submit their proposals, ensuring timely planning and execution. Once the proposals are received from states, further action will be taken for the approval of GEC III.

When can we see awarding of offshore wind projects under the VGF scheme?

Under the VGF scheme, SECI issued the first tender for a 500 MW offshore wind energy project off the Gujarat coast in September. The pre-bid meeting for the project was held in December. The bid submission deadline is March 19, and the project is expected to be awarded in FY26. Additionally, the offshore wind study and survey for the 500 MW capacity off the Tamil Nadu coast under the scheme is expected to be completed by October 2025. The tender for this site will be issued subsequently.

The budget mentions intra-state capacity augmentation. Have any plans been formulated?
