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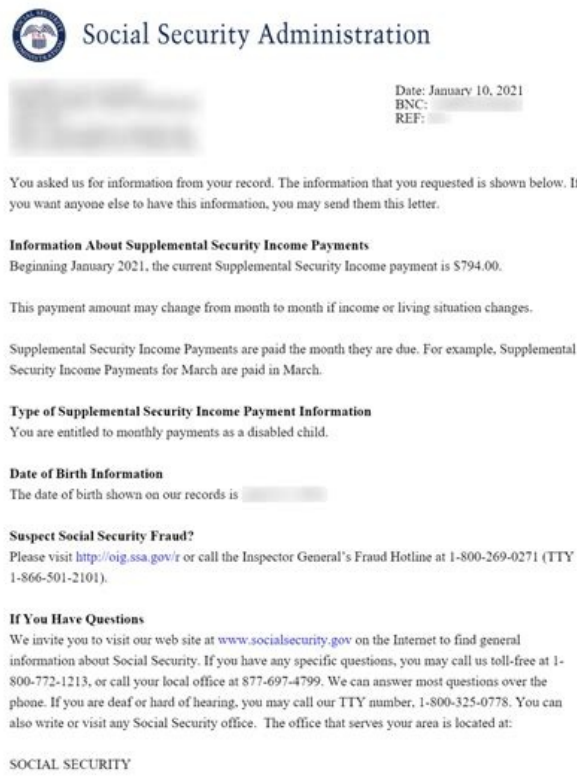
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## What does a benefit verification letter look like

You will know that you have been approved for Social Security disability benefits when the employee receives a letter from the Social Security Administration (SSA). This letter is sometimes also called a permission letter. If your application is approved in the first stage, you will actually receive the Disability Disability Case (DDS), State Power, Social Security Disability Award Ceremony. [yaze](#) You may be lucky enough to have Social Security approve your disability claim during the initial application period. In this case, you will receive a letter confirming your disability in a month or two after the decision of the State Service for Persons with Disabilities (SDS). But first, DDS must refer your case to Social Security to finally consider that Social Security may send an award letter called a Notice of Award. DDS needs three to six months for a preliminary decision before it can send a case to Social Security.



Social Security letters usually also answer most applicants' payment questions, such as whether you can expect a monthly benefit for one month.

**Our Decision**

The hearing decision is attached to this letter. Our decision deals only with whether you are disabled. If our decision causes a change in your benefits, you will get another letter.

If you agree with our decision, you don't have to do anything.

#### If You Disagree With The Decision

If you disagree with the decision, you have the right to request a hearing. A person who has not seen your case before will look at it. That person is an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). The ALJ will review your case again and consider any new facts you have before deciding your case.

- You have 60 days to ask for a hearing.
- The 60 days start the day after you receive this letter. We assume you got this letter 5 days after the date on it unless you show that you did not get it within the 5-day period.

### We May Owe You Additional Benefits

We have been reducing your Social Security disability benefits because you also received California State Disability Insurance (SDI) payments. SDI payments usually stop after one year. Since our records show that you started receiving SDI payments more than a year ago, we may owe you money if your SDI payments have stopped.

### What We Need You To Do

If you recently gave us proof that your SDI payments stopped, you can ignore this letter. Otherwise, follow these instructions:

### 1. Send Us Proof of Your California SDI Payments

Please send us one of the following documents so that we can decide if you are due more money:

- The last payment stub you received from the state Employment Development Department (EDD) showing "Notice of Exhaustion of Disability Benefits" or
  - A letter or form from the Employment Development Department showing a record of your payments or that no benefits were paid to you.

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DDS needs three to six months for a preliminary decision before it can send a case to Social Security. How long does it take to receive a confirmation letter at the application review stage? If you are appealing a denial, DDS will consider your request and it is called a "renewal." If Social Security approves your claim at the Work Incentive Reevaluation stage, the same delay will occur in DDS. Currently, the DDS issues a decision within an average of 180 days, i.e. six months. If you claimed a denial and were awarded a disability pension after going before an administrative law judge, you will need to wait at least a month or two after the inquiry to receive approval. Even if the judge seems to agree that you are disabled, after the hearing he may have to look more closely at your case to decide when you became disabled.

that is the day the judge agrees (the "start date"), may differ from the expected start date.
