RULES, MEDIA RELEASE AND NOTICES:

All subject to change without notice.

GAME RULE: Must be present to win. Tickets cost one dollar. No limit on individual ticket purchases. Please stay single file and do not hold place in line. We reserve right to accommodate people unable to stand in line.

We draw one ticket each evening. Ticket holder selects one card to turn over. If it is the Jack of Hearts, that person wins 50% of pot. If not, pot rolls over to following week.

TAXES AND LOGISTICS: Winner must complete W-9 form when receiving prize. Winner is solely responsible for paying any and all applicable taxes and duties related to prize(s) and for notifying us of address change before 1099s are filed. Pot winners typically meet JOH member at Winner's Circle bowling alley the following day to fill out W-9 and collect money. If winner has 'pooled' ticket purchases with friends, winnings can be split between those people, but each person must complete a W-9 in order to receive money.

SCHEDULE CHANGES: Weather, illness and holidays often cause us to cancel one or more JOH weekly drawings. In event of a cancellation, we announce the change by a) posting a notice on the JOH Board at Winners Circle, b) posting a notice on our Facebook page and c) posting any lengthy pauses on our website: www.canmanfund.com.

We reserve the right to implement any or all BIG POT RULES at any time. This typically happens when pot gets big and crowds increase accordingly, making it difficult for everyone to get through the line by 7:30. BIG POT RULES may include, but are not limited to, the following procedure changes: 1) starting ticket sales earlier in the evening so that more people can purchase 2) extending the time to sell tickets, 3) implementing a 'cut off' point to indicate when/where ticket sales will end 4) changing the method of sales to make a more efficient process.
