




Scholarship Eligibility Criteria



This one-year scholarship is open to **African American female high school seniors** currently enrolled in a **Martin County** or **Port St. Lucie high schools**.

To be considered, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Selection is based on **academic achievement, leadership, and community service**.
2. Applicants must have a **minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8**.
3. Applicants must submit a **completed scholarship application** with all required supporting documents by the stated deadline.
4. Recorded and submitted video (*Optional: Completion earns additional points.*)

Application Timeline

- **Applications due:** March 1, 2025
- Applications will be reviewed by the **Project Pink & Green Foundation Scholarship Committee**.
- Selected finalists will be **invited to participate in an interview**.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced **April–May** during the school's **Scholarship/Awards Night ceremony**.

Award Details

- In **2026**, four (4) scholarships of **\$2,500** each will be awarded:
 - Two (2) students from **Martin County high schools**
 - Two (2) students from **Port St. Lucie high schools**
- The number and amount of scholarships awarded may vary annually based on **foundation bylaws and available funding**.

Disbursement Requirements

- Scholarship recipients must provide **proof of college enrollment** to the Project Pink & Green Foundation.
- Scholarship funds will be **issued directly to the recipient's college or university** and disbursed during the **fall semester**.



- Submissions should be well-organized, grammatically correct, and clearly express your ideas.

Video Submission

As part of the scholarship application process, applicants are asked to submit a 2-3 minute video responding to the question listed below. This video provides the Scholarship Committee with an opportunity to learn more about you beyond your written materials.

Guidelines:

- The video must be 2-3 minutes in length
- Applicants should clearly address all questions below
- Videos may be recorded using a phone, tablet, or computer
- Please ensure clear audio and visibility
- Submit your video by the required deadline and submit with your application

Video Question: *What college or university do you intend to attend, and what factors were most important in your decision-making process?*

Applicants are expected to wear appropriate attire and present themselves in a way that reflects the importance of this scholarship opportunity.
