Fort Phantom Boat Rentals Frequently Asked Questions

1. Q. How old do I have to be to rent a vessel/boat? (not drive)

A. You must be 21 years or older with a valid driver's license and a valid credit/debit card.

2. Q. How old do I have to be to drive a vessel/boat?

- A. Per Texas State Law you must meet these guidelines:
- Born on or after September 1, 1993, and passed a boater education class or equivalency examination prescribed by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, or
- Born before September 1, 1993, or,
- Persons requiring boater education who have not completed it must be accompanied by a person 18 years of age (who can legally operate) or older, or
- At least 13 years of age and have passed a boater education course or equivalency examination prescribed by the department.

4. Q. What is not allowed on the vessel?

A. We ask that you not bring glass or anything that will burn, stain, or rip the seats. Please also be aware of wearing any tie-dyed clothing or tanning lotion/oils that will stain the seats and cause them to need replacing *at the renter's cost*.

5. Q. Does a baby count as a person on the vessel?

A. Per Texas State Law, each person including babies counts as a person on the vessel/boat.

6. Q. Can I bring my pets on the boat?

A. Although we are pet lovers we cannot permit pets on board any of our vessels.

7. Q. Will I need to bring my own cooler for drinks or snacks?

A. It is up to you! You are allowed to bring your own or you can rent one from us.

8. Q. What is included with my rental?

A. Use of the vessel you have rented and life jackets for all passengers.

9. Q. Do you have other add-ons that I can add to my rental?

A. Yes. We offer inner tubes, floating pads, and pullable inflatables for a separate fee.

10. Q. Do I need to pay for the vessel's gas?

A. No, you do not.

11. Q. Can we bring alcohol on the rental?

A. You are permitted to bring alcohol on the boat only. However, those who are drinking must be over 21+ and the driver must be sober at all times. Drinking while operating a jet ski is prohibited.
