Here are a few suggested questions:

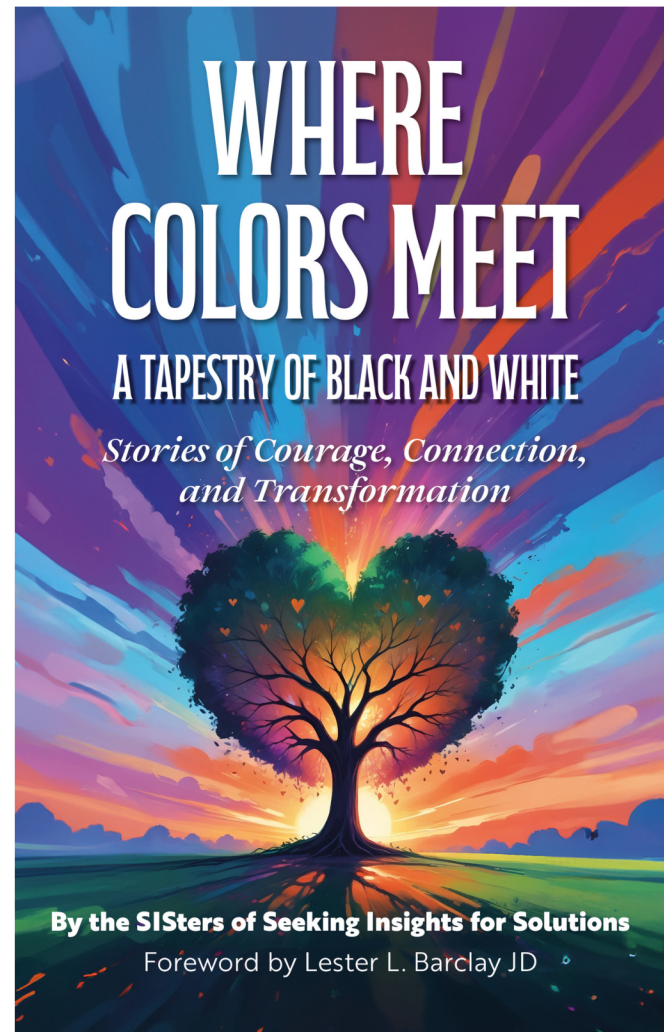
- What is the significance of the tapestry metaphor?
