## NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

### ENTRIES

- **Closing Date:** Entries close at **5:00 P.M on April 26, 2019**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or canceled as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. All overnight entries must be marked “Signature Waived”. **No entry will be accepted, canceled or changed after the closing date. Telephone, electronic, and faxed entries cannot be accepted.**
- **Entry Fees:** Obedience and rally are separate trials. Obedience and rally trial fees for each day are \$25.00 for first entry of each dog in a regular obedience, alternative titling, optional titling or rally class,. Entry in a nonregular class or additional entry of a dog that is already entered in a regular, alternative titling, optional titling or rally class is \$15.00. All fees must be enclosed. Checks should be made payable to “DTCT” (Returned Checks will be assessed a \$25.00 fee.)
- **AKC Recording Fees:** Per AKC, “A recording fee of \$3.50 will be required for each dog entered. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the recording fee will be collected on the first entry only.” The recording fee is included in the trial entry fee.
- If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refunds of entries will be made.
- **Transfers (moveups):** Transfers for the Saturday, May 11 trials must be submitted to the Trial Secretary by Monday, May 6. Transfers for the Sunday, May 12 trials must be submitted to the Trial Secretary by the close of Saturday’s trials. Contact or see the Trial Secretary for transfer forms.

### TRIAL SITE

- Overnight parking at the trial site is NOT allowed. **There is no space for RVs.**
- The building will be air conditioned for the dogs’ comfort.

### RALLY EXHIBITORS

- If your Rally class requires a jump height (because the class will be ordered by jump height) you **MUST** supply a jump height on your entry form or the trial secretary will not accept your entry. The Trial Secretary will not contact you for this information.

<u>Height of Dog at Withers</u>	<u>Jump Height</u>
Less than 10 inches	4 inches
10 inches to less than 15 inches	8 inches
15 inches to less than 20 inches	12 inches
<u>20</u> inches and over	16 inches

- Rally jump heights for Saturday will be 16”- 4”, and Sunday, 4”- 16”.
- Rally transfers from Rally Novice to Rally Intermediate require a jump height on the transfer form.

**You are expected to understand the Rally Rules and understand which Rally class “A” or “B” at any level to enter. The rules differ between the Rally Novice class, Intermediate and Advanced/Excellent and Master classes. Be advised that your leg will not count if you earn it in the wrong class! ## **OTHER**

- Food and drinks will **not** be available for sale on the premises. However, there are a number of fast food restaurants closeby.
- Dogs should be present at least ½ hour prior to judging and will be excused immediately after the class unless needed for further judging.
- Due to space constraints, unentered dogs and X-pens are not allowed on the premises during the Trials.
- Obedience jump heights will be 8” – 36” on Saturday and 36” – 8” on Sunday.

## **CLASS PRIZES**

Ribbons, 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place, will be awarded in all classes. Additionally 1<sup>st</sup> place winners will receive a handmade tug toy. Prizes will be awarded in the ring by the Judge at the end of the class. Green qualifying ribbons will be presented to all who qualify in the regular classes. Rosettes and a certificate for one free entry in a future DTCT trial will be awarded for obedience High in Trial, obedience High Combined score in Open and Utility, rally High Combined score in Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent, and rally High Combined Triple score in Rally Advanced, Rally Excellent and Rally Master.

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## **ENTRY BLANK INSTRUCTIONS FROM AKC**

1. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
2. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners SM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club’s option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

## **HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK**

Use **one entry form for each dog**. You may use a single form for both days if the dog is entered in the same class(es) each day. Be sure to check the blocks for each trial you wish to enter. **If the entries differ between days, please use separate forms for each day**. Remember that obedience and rally are separate trials and the fee for the first entry in each is \$25.00. Second entry of the same dog in the same trial on the same day and nonregular class entries are \$15.00. (Please see the “Entry” section under the Notices to Exhibitors above for more information.)

Be sure that

- That all the information on the entry is **LEGIBLE**.
- To include **JUMP HEIGHTS, REGISTRATION NUMBERS, DOG’S FULL REGISTERED NAME** and **GENDER**.
- When there are A and B classes, be sure to specify which one the dog is entered in.
- To not forget to sign and include the Agreement on the back of the entry form with your entry.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
