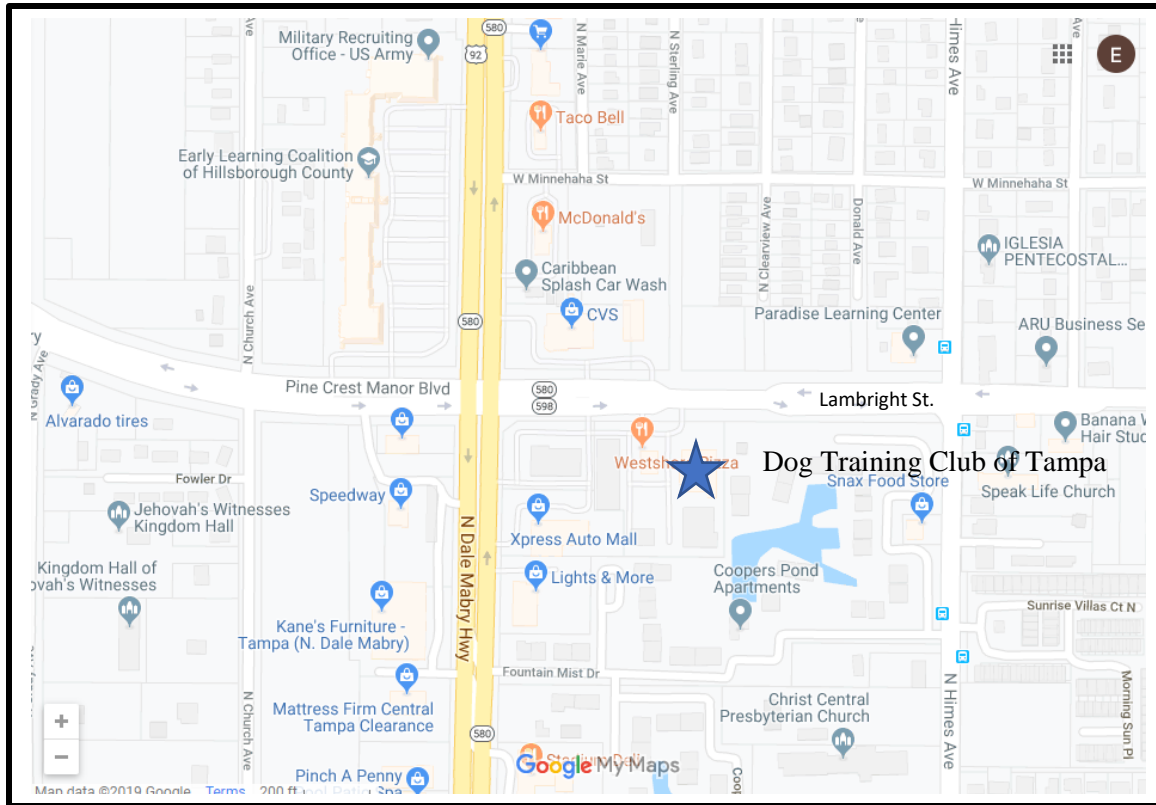

NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES

- **Electronic submission of entries. payment of entry fees by credit card, and pdf. format fillable Entry and Agreement forms** are now available for exhibitors' convenience. **Please see the instructions at the end of this Premium for directions on how to use these options.**
- **Entry Fees: Obedience and rally are separate trials.** Obedience and rally trial fees for each day are \$27.00 for first entry of each dog in a regular obedience, alternative titling, optional titling or rally class,. Entry in a nonregular class or additional entry of a dog that is already entered in a regular, alternative titling, optional titling or rally class is \$16.00.
- **Credit Card Surcharge:** There is a Paypal surcharge for entry fee payments by credit card. See entry form directions for surcharge amounts.
- **AKC Recording Fees:** Per AKC, "A recording fee of \$3.50 will be required for each dog entered If a dog is entered in more than one class, the recording fee will be collected on the first entry only." **The recording fee is included in the trial entry fee.**
- **Closing Date:** Entries close at **5:00 P.M on Friday October 11, 2019**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or canceled as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. All overnight entries must be marked "Signature Waived". **No entry will be accepted, canceled or changed after the closing date.** The exception is for bitches that come in season after the closing.
- **Transfers (moveups):** Transfers for the Saturday, October 26, 2019 trials must be submitted to the Trial Secretary by Monday, October 21, 2019. Transfers for the Sunday, October 27 trials must be submitted to the Trial Secretary by the close of Saturday's trials. Contact or see the Trial Secretary for transfer forms.
- If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refunds of entries will be made.

TRIAL SITE

- There is no room for RV's on the trial site. Overnight parking is NOT allowed.
- The building will be air conditioned for the dogs' comfort.

RALLY EXHIBITORS

- If your Rally class requires a jump height (because the class will be ordered by jump height) you **MUST** supply a jump height on your entry form or the trial secretary will not accept your entry. The Trial Secretary will not contact you for this information.

| <u>Height of Dog at Withers</u> | <u>Jump Height</u> |
|----------------------------------|--------------------|
| Less than 10 inches | 4 inches |
| 10 inches to less than 15 inches | 8 inches |

- Rally jump heights for Saturday will be 16"- 4", and Sunday, 4"- 16".
- Rally transfers from Rally Novice to Rally Intermediate require a jump height on the transfer form.
- **From Ch.6, Section 1, of the AKC Rally Regulations:**

***Rally Pairs Class.** Rally Pairs class consists of competition by one handler working two dogs at one time through a rally course at a level selected and offered by the event-giving club. Scores will be based on a possible 200 points, with ties being broken by time. Class levels that can be offered by the event giving club will be Rally Novice, Rally Advanced or Rally Excellent, excluding jumps. Clubs may offer one or all levels at events. A club may offer non-regular Rally Excellent without having to offer any other level as a non-regular class.*

***Scoring:** All signs will be counted with a point value. The maximum point value that can be deducted at any one sign will be 10 points per dog (20 total points). There will not be any NQ's awarded for a performance. It is possible for a team to receive a negative score. All other rally rules and Regulations will apply for each class level offered as a non-regular class.*

Suggested judging is 12 pairs per hour.

Event-sponsoring clubs are allowed to determine the level of any Rally Pairs class to be offered. A Rally Intermediate level course will be used for the Rally Pairs class at this trial. All exercises will be performed on leash. There will be no jump. The Rally Pairs entry fee is **\$16.00 per dog for a total of \$32.00**. A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog entered in Rally Pairs.

You are expected to understand the Rally Rules and understand which Rally class "A" or "B" at any level to enter. The rules differ between the Rally Novice class, Intermediate and Advanced/Excellent and Master classes. Be advised that your leg will not count if you earn it in the wrong class! Consult the AKC rules for Rally at www.akc.org

OTHER

- Food and drinks will **not** be available for sale on the premises. However, there are a number of fast food restaurants closeby.
- Dogs should be present at least ½ hour prior to judging and will be excused immediately after the class unless needed for further judging.
- Due to space constraints, unentered dogs and X-pens are not allowed on the premises during the Trials.
- Obedience jump heights will be 8” – 36” on Saturday and 36” – 8” on Sunday.

RALLY & OBEDIENCE WARMUP RINGS will be available starting ½ hour before the beginning of judging until judging is completed for the day. Cost is \$5 for 5 minutes. Assistance in setting up and adjusting jumps will be available in the obedience practice ring. The rally practice ring will be a multilevel course with 13-15 stations. Assistance will also be available to adjust jump heights.

ENTRY BLANK INSTRUCTIONS FROM AKC

1. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a dog is acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
2. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners SM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

HOW TO SEND IN AN ENTRY

Entry Preparation: There are two ways to prepare the Entry and Agreement forms for these trials.

- **Entry Preparation Option 1**—The preferred entry preparation option uses the Entry and Agreement forms formatted as pdf. fillable forms. Both forms are in a computerized file that is separate from the Premium but is attached to the same email as the Premium. The file is “Entry & Agreement.pdf.”. After opening the file, tab from box to box, and enter the text, or click on the small box to complete the forms. In the top section of the Entry form click on the box(es) next to the class(es) you wish to enter in each trial. Enter the jump height in the next column where needed. Then enter the entry fee in the box to the right of the jump height box. Put the total entry fee for each trial at the bottom of the entry fee column. In the bottom row enter the total entry fee for all trials and the Paypal surcharge. Put the total amount submitted in the last box on the right. Enter the dog’s information and the owner’s information in the lower boxes. Be sure to include **REGISTRATION NUMBERS, the DOG’S OFFICIAL NAME and GENDER**. Input your name in the signature boxes on both forms. So there is no need to fill anything out by hand. (We strongly recommend that you use this option for ease of completing the form and saving the Trial Secretaries’ eyes from illegible handwriting.)
- **Entry Preparation Option 2**---Copies of the Entry and Agreement are part of this premium per instructions from AKC and must be filled out by hand. The form is filled the same way as the Option 1 forms, except that boxes are checked and the text is handwritten. Last, sign at the bottom. If any information on hand-scribed forms is illegible, the entry will not be processed, and the handler will be requested to redo the entry using the fillable form or email the information. The Agreement form only requires entering the owner’s name, telephone number, email address and another signature.

Payment of Entry Fees: You may pay the entry fees either by check or using a credit card.

- **Payment by Check**--Checks should be made out to “DTCT” and mailed to the Trial Secretaries.
- **Payment by Credit Card:**--If you wish the convenience of using a credit card, you must use your personal Paypal account. Open the account, click the “Send” button, enter “DTCTampa@yahoo.com“ in the box and follow the prompts from there. There is a surcharge for using the Paypal account. To send amounts under \$30, add \$2; for \$30-\$99 add \$3; for \$100 or over add \$4.

Entry Submission: There are likewise two ways to submit entry forms to the Trial Secretaries.
