As we draw close to the end of our fiscal year, the Board of Directors is so pleased of all the improvements to date, although there are a few projects left to complete.

On November 19th, our budget for 2021 was approved with a 3% increase, bringing our HOA dues to \$257. The small increase is due to a massive increase in water usage (mostly due to the pandemic as most residents are now home), an increase in insurance premiums, as well as a few contracted services. Overall, because of having a good budget this year as well as collection on age balances, along with renegotiated contracts, only a small increase was necessary.

We are happy to announce that our community will have its first holiday tree lighting and this will take place early next month as soon as all the landscaping detail is complete.
