

Douglas Elementary PTO Meeting Minutes Thursday, November 13, 2025 DES Media Center

Meeting called to order by Raechel Hardin at 3:28pm All members were present; 2 guests in attendance

I. President Update (Raechel Hardin)

A. Raechel proposed putting up Christmas lights/decorations to make the school look more festive in the morning. Becky suggested getting high school art students to paint the windows. A lead would be needed for this.

B. Committees

- 1. Raechel will serve as lead for Teacher Appreciation Week this year and is seeking a co-lead and extra volunteers.
- 2. We need committee leads for next year including Christmas lights, walk-a-thon evening event, and book fair. Michaelle suggested meeting face-to-face with parents at events such as back-to-school night/conferences to recruit leads/volunteers.
- C. We still have an at-large board position to fill.

II. Treasurer Update (Renee Russell)

- A. Renee presented the treasurer's report for the month of October. One area of concern is the snack closet as funds are being depleted, and money will run out by February at this rate. Michaelle and the office have brainstormed how to move forward with snacks; one idea is to have the resource room get snacks from a different place. Raechel suggested implementing a monthly cutoff and finding more budget-friendly snacks (e.g. pretzels). Wipes and cleaning supplies are part of the snack expenses, so we may need to track this.
- B. The audit done by Heidi Hunt has been completed. Heidi pointed out good increases in transparency and reporting. One recommendation to keep in mind is her suggestion to have an executive meeting in June since that's the end of our fiscal year. The audit will be posted on the PTO website.

 - 1. Most of the supplies have been purchased and prepped for students to make fun holiday gifts for a parent/loved one.
 - 2. Stephanie Allen has organized a schedule of time slots for teachers. Alison and Traci plan to send out a signup genius before Thanksgiving break to recruit parent volunteers to assist.
