First-Time Revolutionary War Outfit Reimbursements

- On February 1, 2020, the NC SAR Board of Managers approved a \$100 financial incentive to help rebuild the Color Guard of the NC Society by encouraging Compatriots to acquire and wear a Revolutionary War outfit at events. The form is now available to obtain a \$100 reimbursement

from the State. Reach out to the Raleigh Chapter leadership. To do so, (1) a Compatriot acquires a complete Revolutionary War era uniform or outfit for the first time; (2) participates in a Color Guard function or other SAR-related activity (i.e., giving an award, giving a presentation, manning a recruiting table, etc.) wearing the RW era outfit, (3) has the form verified with a signature from your Chapter President, Vice President, or Chapter Color Guard Commander; and (4) sends form to our State Treasurer Sam Powell for reimbursement. Reimbursements are retroactive to September 1, 2019

Raleigh Chapter Looking to Support the Veterans Life Center - Bob Sigmon

The Raleigh Chapter is considering providing support to the new Veterans Life Center North Carolina (VLC) in Butner, NC. The VLC is a planned residential facility for 21st century veterans experiencing problems reintegrating to civilian life and is designed to help prevent them from falling into crisis – chronic homelessness, incarceration, suicide, or premature death.

Construction of the VLC's SECU Veterans Residence Building is nearing completion and is expected to open once coronavirus restrictions are lifted. At full capacity, it will house approximately 100 male and female veterans and it will coordinate a battery of services including mental, behavioral and physical health therapy, life skills training, spiritual and family counseling, and vocational education.

Chapter leadership received a briefing from Founder John Turner and VLC Executive Director, Brigadier General (Ret) Thomas A. Gorry at their offices in North Raleigh and we have invited Brigadier Gen. Gorry to speak at our next lunch meeting when we have a firm date. We are contemplating sponsoring an office or a bedroom in the facility and possible providing operating funds going forward. We are also accepting pledges from members for matching funds.
