News in the Faith

New Wine -New Wine, which is a training for lay ecclesial ministers, is planning it's next 3 year New Wine Group. They are looking for members of the parish who want to prepare for some form of lay ecclesial ministry. Applications are due by July 31, 2020. Participants pay \$150 per year for 3 years and the parish pays \$150 per person per year for 3 years. Location and meeting times will be determined when all applications are in. They are hoping to once again have enough people for 3 groups (1 at St Thomas in Long Beach, 1 at St Alphonsus in Ocean Springs and 1 at Sacred Heart in Hattiesburg). Classes begin in August of 2020.
