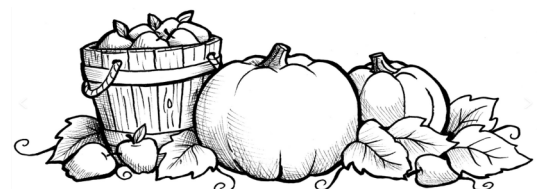

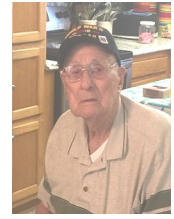

**Fun Facts-10 Commandments**

Exodus 20:1-17 lists the Ten Commandments in the following order: worship only God, worship no idols and do not misuse God's name. Keep the Sabbath holy and honor one's parents. Do not murder, commit adultery or steal. Do not bear false witness or covet one's neighbor's possessions, servants or wife. The Commandments are listed in descending order of importance. The first four mandate one's obligations toward God. The fifth, honoring one's parents, pertains to one's family and heritage. The other five proscribe crimes against the community, in descending order of severity: murder, marital infidelity, theft, betrayal through lying and envy.
