God Knows Us by Name

In the design stage of the Edsel, Ford Motor Company called it the E Car, with E standing for "experimental." A hired marketing firm listed thousand of other names, all destined for the scrap paper heap. An award winning poet offered suggestions, but "Utopian Turtletop" didn't exactly convey the image of a fleet and futuristic automobile. For lack of a better idea Edsel cars got named after Henry Ford's son.

On the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (September 8), the Gospel reading recalls an angel instructing Joseph to give the name Jesus to Mary's expected Child. The name for God's only begotten Son means "Yahweh is salvation."

In the Old Testament, God called the prophet Ezekiel "Son of Man." In the New Testament, Jesus often referred to Himself by the title. "Son of Man" acknowledges our Lord's humanity but hits as His fulfillment of the prophesied coming of our Savior.

One day Jesus asked the Disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" John the Baptist, Elijah, and other prophets made the list. Saint Peter got the right idea when he called Jesus the Messiah. Then the Lord said that the Son of Man would suffer, die, and rise three days later. Suffering the death definitely did not fit with Peter's image of the Messiah, and he had no idea what rising in three days meant.

Edsel automobiles had rotating, domed speedometers with the look of today's dashboard compasses. Optional pushing button shifting on the steering wheel provided an alternative to standard stick shifts. Innovative childproof locks and the ability to pop open the trunk from the driver's seat offered safety and convenience. Still, the utopian hopes for the Edsel dwindled as sales slowed to a turtle's pace.

"Utopian Turtletop" conveyed the ideas of perfection and protections—not a name for the Edsel after all, but Jesus might have liked it as an image of heaven and the Father's protective love.

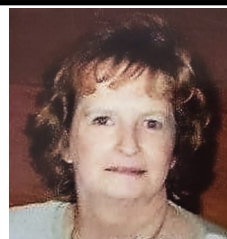
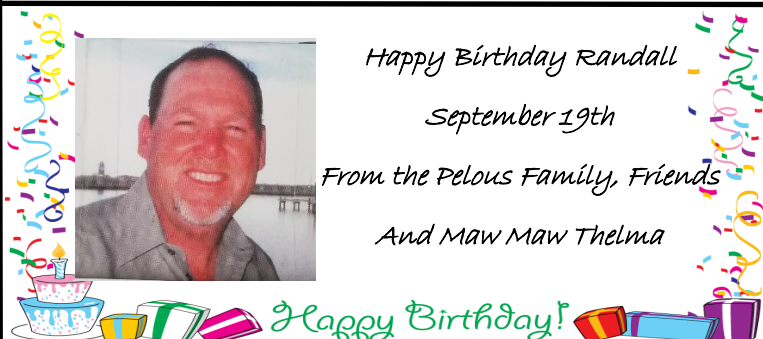
