What is Palanca? What is a Palanca? A Palanca letter is one that is sent to the Cursillo Weekend (Candidates & Team), informing them of prayers and sacrifices that you are offering to God on their behalf. A letter may be sent explaining what type of Palanca is being offered, but the letter is NOT the Palanca.
