

Bed Bug Treatment Preparation Checklist

Check List:

- Strip the bed(s) and launder all sheets, pillowcases, mattress pads and blankets.
- Remove all contents from the bedroom closet(s) and place in sealed plastic bags.
- Remove all contents from dresser drawers, nightstands, and dressing tables. Place all contents in sealed plastic bags.
- Launder all clothing and fabrics (hot water and hot dryer 2 cycles) or dry-cleaned.
- Remove drapes/curtains and launder or dry-clean.
- Discard cardboard boxes, shoeboxes, paper/plastic bags, old newspapers, magazines and similar items in all potentially infested rooms.
- Vacuum all infested rooms, including the floor, mattresses, bedsprings, couches, chairs, closets/closet shelves, shoes, inside dresser drawers, nightstand and etc. Vacuum bags should be placed in a sealed plastic bag and discarded.

Important Notes:

- Discarding of any compromised (ripped/torn) materials or heavily infested items may be required.
- Dismantling of bed frames and other items will be performed as part of the service program.
- Should the box springs remain, removal of the cheesecloth underside is required for proper inspection and/or treatment.
- If laundering, a hot water and detergent cycle plus 2 hot dryer cycles must be used.
- A clutter free environment must be provided so technician can properly access and treat all areas.
- Bagged items should remain sealed until after the follow up. If any items are removed from bags the client should inspect for pest activity.
- The client should not move or touch any monitoring devices placed by the technician.
- The client **MUST NOT** attempt any self-treatment before or during the process.
- Removal of cheesecloth from the bottom of the furniture is required.
