PRIMITIVE CAMPER APPLICATION 2025

As of 2004, The FBRA Board of Directors has made a decision to make the Fort Bridger Rendezvous an <u>Invitation Only Event</u>. Primitive Camps will be judged on cleanliness, appearance, personal conduct and compliance with the Rules and Regulations of all those associated with your camp. Violations may result in a loss of invitation.

By submitting an application and fees, this does not guarantee a Primitive Camp Space on the Fort Grounds. Your cleared check is not a guarantee. FBRA encourages all campers to apply. If you wish to be eligible for a primitive camp space, your application must be postmarked by March 1st 2025. After that date, you will be charged a \$10.00 late fee and all primitive camp sites will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. FBRA Members will be given first priority. Confirmation will be emailed/mailed out no later than June 1st, 2025 for applications submitted by March 1st 2025.

No refunds will be issued after August 1, 2025

The F.B.R.A. operates under a contract with the State of Wyoming. This contract contains a grievance procedure which we are required to follow. If you have a problem which you have not been able to resolve with the help of a F.B.R.A. Board, please contact the F.B.R.A. Secretary at the registration building for a copy of the grievance policy. After Rendezvous the F.B.R.A. Secretary may be contacted by mail, phone, or email as listed above to obtain this policy.

FORT BRIDGER RENDEZVOUS ASSOCIATION PRIMITIVE CAMPER LEASE AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into the date last affixed, by and between the Fort Bridger Rendezvous Association hereinafter referred to as F.B.R.A. 1967 North 950 West, Clinton, UT 84015 and Primitive Camper name, address and phone number attached, hereinafter referred to as Primitive Camper.

One member from each camp needs to attend a Fire Council either Saturday or Sunday at 7:00 p.m. at the Bandstand.

The Camper desires to lease a primitive camp space at the Fort Bridger Rendezvous subject to the conditions stated herein. It is expressly understood that space and space location is allocated at the sole and complete discretion of F.B.R.A. and that you are here by invitation of the FBRA. The parties agree as follows:

- 1. **Space Number:** F.B.R.A. leases the Primitive Camp space no. _____ from the Thursday prior to the Tuesday following Labor Day, to coincide with the annual Fort Bridger Rendezvous.
- 2. <u>Purpose:</u> The Camper shall use said space for a primitive style camp and shall display only rendezvous accepted camp equipment. All Campers shall comply with any reasonable requests made by Primitive Camper Committee.
- 3. <u>Display Times:</u> The Primitive Camper agrees to have his/her space set-up and ready to rendezvous no later than 8:00 a.m. the Saturday prior to Labor Day. All vehicles must be off site by 10:00 p.m. Friday and may not enter the site until 2:00 p.m. on Monday, Labor Day. When leaving on Monday, Labor Day camps must be torn down and cleared by a Dog Solider, or an F.B.R.A. Board Member before you can get in line at the gates. All structures and must be torn down and off site by 12:00 noon the Tuesday following Labor Day. All vehicles must be removed from the State site as soon as space is set-up or tore down.
- 4. **Rent:** The Primitive Camper shall pay to F.B.R.A. the agreed rental of space at the time of application. Due March 1st of each year. Application received after March 1st will pay a \$10.00 late fee and be on a first come first serve basis. Request for refund must be made by August 1st, and will be given only if F.B.R.A. is able to fill the cancelled space.
- 5. **F.B.R.A. Access:** F.B.R.A. and its agents or assigns shall have access to the described space and premises at all times.
- 6. <u>Location:</u> F.B.R.A. reserves the right to locate any Primitive Camper where it is in the best interest of F.B.R.A., and reserves the right to cancel or refuse <u>ANY</u> Camper that is not in the best interest of F.B.R.A. at any time.
- 7. **Regulations:** The Primitive Camper activities and conduct shall be governed by the policies stated in the Trader/ Demo/Camper Rendezvous Rules and Regulations, which is made a part of this agreement by reference as though contained fully herein.
- 8. <u>Conduct:</u> The Primitive Camper shall conduct his/herself within their assigned space in an orderly and respectful manner at all times and shall keep the area neat, clean and free from rubbish. It is understood that the Primitive Camper is responsible for the actions of his/her family members or any other person or persons connected to his/her space or spaces.
- 9. **Sound Devices:** There shall be no use of any sound device by the Primitive Camper. F.B.R.A. reserves the right to allow any such devices as it deems necessary.
- 10. <u>Structure Size:</u> Due to the limitation of space, tents/tipis shall not exceed 20x20 feet unless prior arrangements have been made. If ropes or poles extend beyond the space allotted permission of the neighboring space must be given. Ropes, poles, or stakes must be set back away from normal walkways and must not obstruct the normal flow of traffic.
- 11. <u>Safety:</u> The Primitive Camper shall provide a fire extinguisher with a current inspection sticker to be located at each display. The extinguisher shall be rated at least a 2A-10B;C and shall be within the assigned space. The camper shall maintain all fire extinguishers.

- 12. <u>Indemnity:</u> The Primitive Camper shall release indemnity and hold harmless the F.B.R.A. and the State of Wyoming and their officers, agents, employees, successors and assignees from any cause of action or claims or demands arising out of this agreement.
- 13. <u>Insurance:</u> The State of Wyoming's Workers Compensation insurance nor the Fort Bridger Rendezvous Association's liability insurance does not cover the camper. Any liabilities incurred in the Primitive Campers assigned space are the sole responsibility of that Camper.
- 14. <u>Laws:</u> The laws of the State of Wyoming shall govern the construction, interpretation, and enforcement of this agreement. The Courts of the State of Wyoming shall have jurisdiction over this agreement and the parties.
- 15. <u>Business:</u> The Primitive Camper shall not engage in any business within the rendezvous site i.e. use camp space as commercial trade space. The Primitive Camper shall not place fliers, posters, etc. within the rendezvous site.
- 16. <u>Unlawful or Dangerous Activity:</u> The Primitive Camper shall neither use nor occupy the premises or any part thereof for any unlawful, disreputable, or ultra-hazardous business purpose nor operate or conduct business in a manner constituting a nuisance of any kind. The Primitive Camper shall immediately upon notification of any unlawful, disreputable or ultra-hazardous use, or nuisance, takes action to halt such activity.
- 17. **Sovereign Immunity:** The State of Wyoming and the Fort Bridger State Historic Site does not waive sovereign immunity and has no part in this agreement.
- 18. <u>Changes:</u> There will be no changes made to or deviation from the terms of this agreement, unless made in writing and signed by all parties hereto. <u>No</u> verbal agreements, past, present or future that are not incorporated in writing herein shall be valid or binding on either party. All representations regarding this agreement are contained herein and understood by the parties hereto.
- 19. **Assignment:** This agreement may not be assigned or transferred.
- 20. **Termination:** The F.B.R.A. reserves the right to terminate this agreement at any time without cause.

This agreement consisting of 1 page, front and back, and the attached Fort Bridger Rendezvous Association Trader/Demo/Camper Rendezvous Rules and Regulations, represent the entire and integrated agreement.

I have fully read and understand the Primitive Camper contract and the FBRA Rules and Regulations. By signing this contract I agree to abide by all rules and regulations required by FBRA and the State of Wyoming.
