

Come enjoy the Bridger Knife and Hawk event. If you are a competitor regardless of your skill level or age, we have an amazing course and encourage you to experience the fun. If you are a flat lander and want to give it a try there are several targets for you with seasoned mountain men to show you how to do it. We will even loan you a hawk!

Friday starts the event with a blanket throw at 2:00. It is open to all in rendezvous dress. Provide a prize worth \$5 or more. This competition helps the range masters and the competitors get tuned in for Saturday's event.

Saturday competition is the big one. We start at 8:00 and is open until 3:00. The entry fee to compete is \$5 and a competitor is allowed to buy back one time to improve their score until 2:00. Mountain man dress is required to compete. There are four divisions: Men, Women, Youth (less than 14 years), and Amateur (those with less than a year experience). The top four scores in the adult divisions qualify for the expert division. At 3:00 the top four scores in each division will have a throw off to determine the winner. We have amazing prizes for the winners and hope you will join us!

Sunday is a much more relaxed competition. In the past we have had a partner's competition and a relay. Come see what we have in store. Competition usually ends in the afternoon. Mountain dress and \$5 entry fee will be required.

Labor Day Monday is open range where the targets are open, but there is no official competition. Mountain Man dress is not required.
