MATH

Early math development doesn't look like you might think. It's not about flashcards or memorizing math facts. Try this fun activity with your toddler -- dump a pile of mixed color pom poms on the table and have them sort by color into an ice cube tray. Want to add some fine motor skills in to the mix? Set out a pair of tongs or tweezers to use instead of fingers.



SCIENCE

Did you know...kids LOVE science. Explorations don't have to be complicated. Check out this recipe for Oobleck -- all you need is water and cornstarch. Is it a solid?? Is it a liquid?? This non-Newtonian fluid is...both. For younger scientists, simply let them play with the mixture. For those in the 4-5 age range, open up a conversation about solids and liquids. Give examples (a block, a glass of water) and encourage conversation about how on earth something can be both! Simply mix 2 parts cornstarch to 1 part water.
