Fannin County Family Connections Presents: The Blue Ridge Soap Box Derby

A little history:

- The Blue Ridge Soap Box Derby (SBD) was created in 2018 and held its inaugural race in April 2019
- It was created to give our local community, especially our youth, an exciting activity that they can do as a family.
- It teaches the next generation all the aspects of the "S.T.E.A.M." program, Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math.
- Thus far, the SBD has given back over \$14,000 to our Fannin County Schools while also paying out over \$1,000 every year in prize money.
- Last year we had 70 drivers and over 50 cars. It is open for anyone 7 and above, even adults.
- Admission is always free to watch and affordable food, snacks and beverages are available.

New for 2024:

- Fannin County Family Connection is assisting in the event management.
- Net proceeds will benefit The Children's Fund at Fannin County School System.

Participation by Drivers & Parents:

- Derby registration forms and fee (\$25) are due by **April 26**. *Late entries will NOT be accepted*.
- To be guaranteed an event t-shirt, registration forms must be received by April 19.
- Race Categories are: 1. Classic Ages 7-12; 2. Classic Age 13+; 3. Outlaw Age 7+
- Driver Registration Forms include a Waiver that must be signed by the Parent/Guardian and a signed Parent's Pledge to adhere to the Parents Code of Coduct.

Driver Participants will be assigned a registration number on check-in, *Friday, May 3* at Fannin County Middle School. Registration hours are *5-7pm*. Drivers will receive their complete registration packets with their event t-shirt on check-in, Friday, May 3 from 5-7pm.

Drivers must arrive at Fannin County Middle School no later than **9:30am on Race Day, Saturday,** May 4.

Drivers: to be guaranteed an event t-shirt, complete and return registration forms by April 19. Final date for registration forms is April 26. Late entries (after April 26) will NOT be accepted.
