Once again, our kids were able to replenish their Spring wardrobes, toys, and books. Following lunch at Chick-fil-A, we returned safely to Blue Ridge at 4 pm, a tired but happy group.

Our monthly Family Care Support Meeting was held on April 1, 2025. Special guests Stacie Hamlin. McKenzie Harris, and Sally Masters gave a program on Fostering Fannin. Fostering Fannin The child welfare system in our community serves and supports children in Foster Care and Kinship Care, and those at risk of entering the child welfare system in our community. Fostering Fannin will be collaborating with Fannin's Family Care Program. Fostering Fannin has also provided half of the cost of a trumpet for one of our Foster kids to help with the price of a trumpet.








Soap Box Derby
