The primary role of arts specialists is to love children and to engage and enrich them through music and movement. Using Songs and Stories, the Arts Specialists conduct 30-minute music and movement classes with preschoolers according to a defined weekly schedule. They use music, instruments, props, movement, puppets, storytelling, and routines to encourage children to sing, move, dance, and play. They build vocabulary and self-esteem and promote gross motor and rhythmic skills. Using a predefined curriculum as a guide, arts specialists integrate their own interests and creativity into lessons. They serve as cheerful, flexible "ambassadors" at all schools and are positive and communicative with school staff and Center staff. Arts specialists train both online and together with other arts specialists and attend regularly scheduled monthly staff meetings at The Craddock Center.

We serve 1,200 children in seven counties in north Georgia (Fannin, Gilmer, Pickens, Union, Towns, Dawson, Lumpkin), Cherokee County, North Carolina and Polk County, Tennessee.
